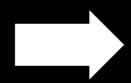
→ GREAT NATION, SEED.

1). How could this Doctrine affect Christians and non-Christians based on today's current events?

→ PROMOTES THE TENDENCY FOR SOME TO FALSELY PROPHECY THAT WE ARE SEEING FULFILLMENT IN THE EVENTS OF TODAY.

→ FOR CHRISTIANS, IT MAY QUESTION OUR FAITH AND CURRENT UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURES LIKE MATT. 24 AND REV.

- Hope for future promises like Heaven may be questioned.
- Weakens our faith in our current redemption in Christ.

6). How does the PM Doctrine affect attitudes toward the Church today?

→ It belittles the glorious church which Christ purchased with His blood.

→ For PM, the church was a substitute...a temporary "band-aid fix" for the failure of Christ to succeed in establishing his kingdom.

7). What does Eph. 3:10, 21 say about our attitudes toward the Church?



The church is the ultimate fulfillment of God's spiritual purposes for His people.

8). How does this Doctrine our attitudes toward different races?



It maintains a distinction between Jew and Gentile...with advantages given to Jews.

9). What does Gal. 3:26-29 and Eph. 2:11-22 tell us about God's distinction from Jew to Gentile?

→ God no longer recognizes differences between Jew and Gentile.
