3. All the families of earth would be blessed, Gen. 12:3.
4. **Demonstrates God is the LORD**, Ex. 4:1,4-5; 5:2; 6:6-7; 7:5,17; 9:16; 10:1-2; 12:31; 15:14-16.

Deut. 31:22, 24-26: Mark 12:19.

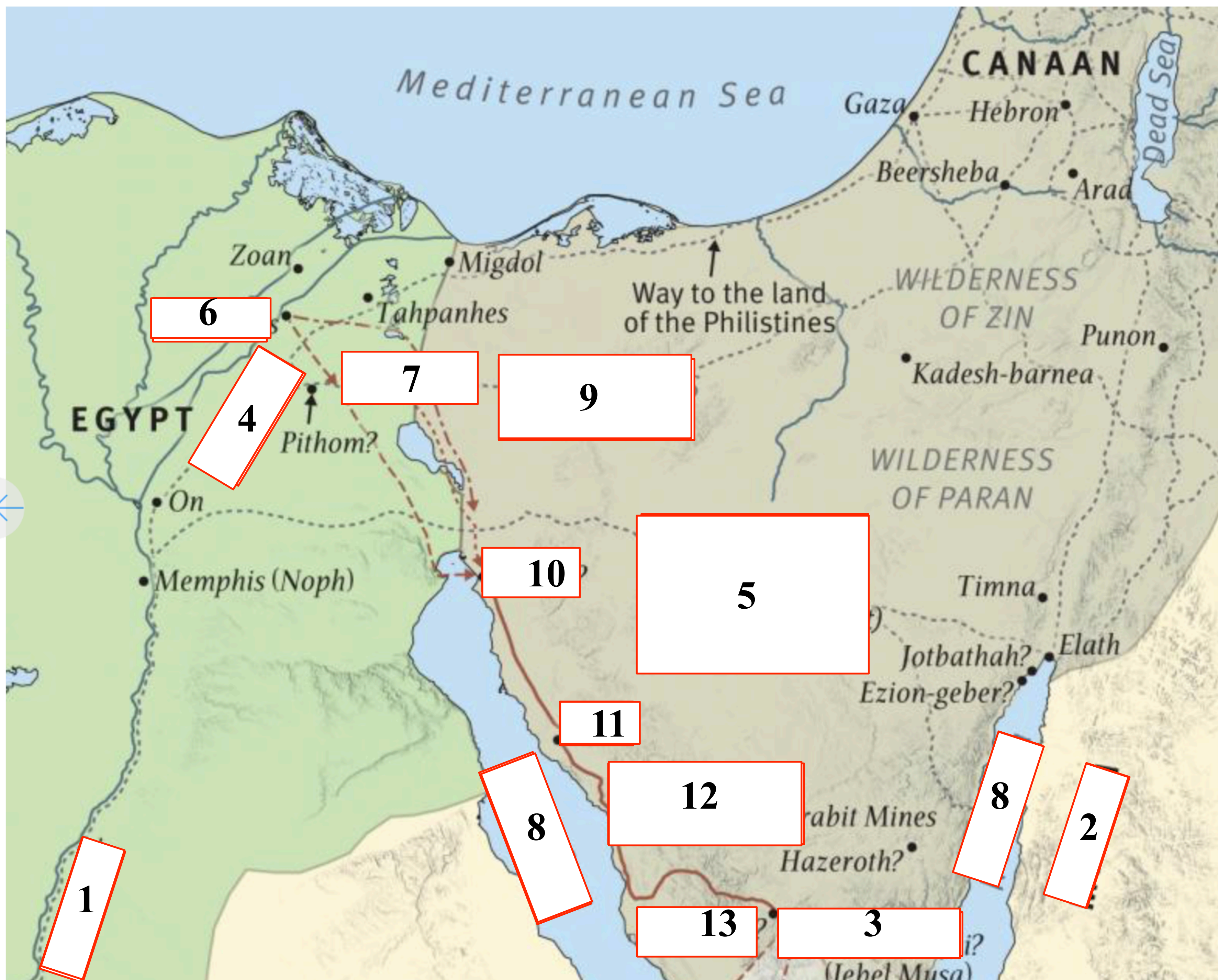

Make no covenant with inhabitants and do not marry them. Be a snare for you.

Set apart the land of Goshen. No swarms of insect there. Know I, the Lord, am in the midst, 8:22.

15. God could have destroyed the Egyptians. What reason is given why He allowed them to live?

Egyptians may know “I am the **LORD**”, 7:3-5

16. What does Pharaoh admit to during the hail?

I have sinned this time, Lord is the righteous one, 9:27.

17. What did the Egyptians fear after the last plague?

- We shall all be dead, 12:33.

18. How long were the Israelites in Egypt?

430 years, 12:40-41.

19. What did the Old Testament Law include? Provide verses.

- The "Law" included more 10 commandments.
- All the OT books came to called the "Law", Ex. 24:8, Deut. 31:24-26, John 10:34, 1 Cor. 14:21, Rom. 3:9-19.

20. What was the purpose of the Old Testament Law? Does it have any bearing on us today?

- The Law was given to lead us to Christ, Gal. 3:19, 22-24.

- Christ is the end (aim) of the law for righteousness, Rom. 10:4.

4. Remember the Sabbath.
5. Honor father and mother that your days may be prolonged in land.

→ Feast of Unleavened Bread, Feast of Harvest and Feast of Ingathering.

★ Feast of Unleavened Bread.

- 14th day of Month Abib, last 7 days to 21st.
- Memorial for deliverance from Egypt esp. killing 1st born.

★ Feast of Harvest.

- April/May.
- Thanksgiving for 1st fruits.

★ Feast of Ingathering.

- 15th day of 7th Month for 7 days.
- Thanksgiving for harvest.

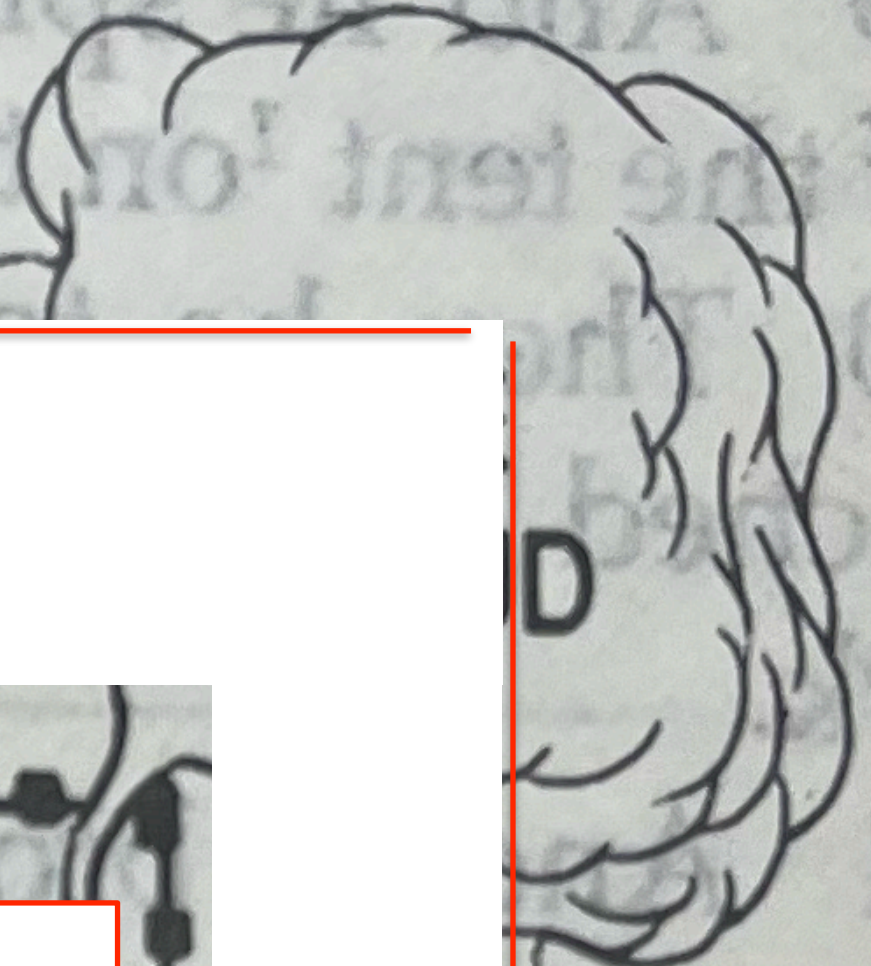
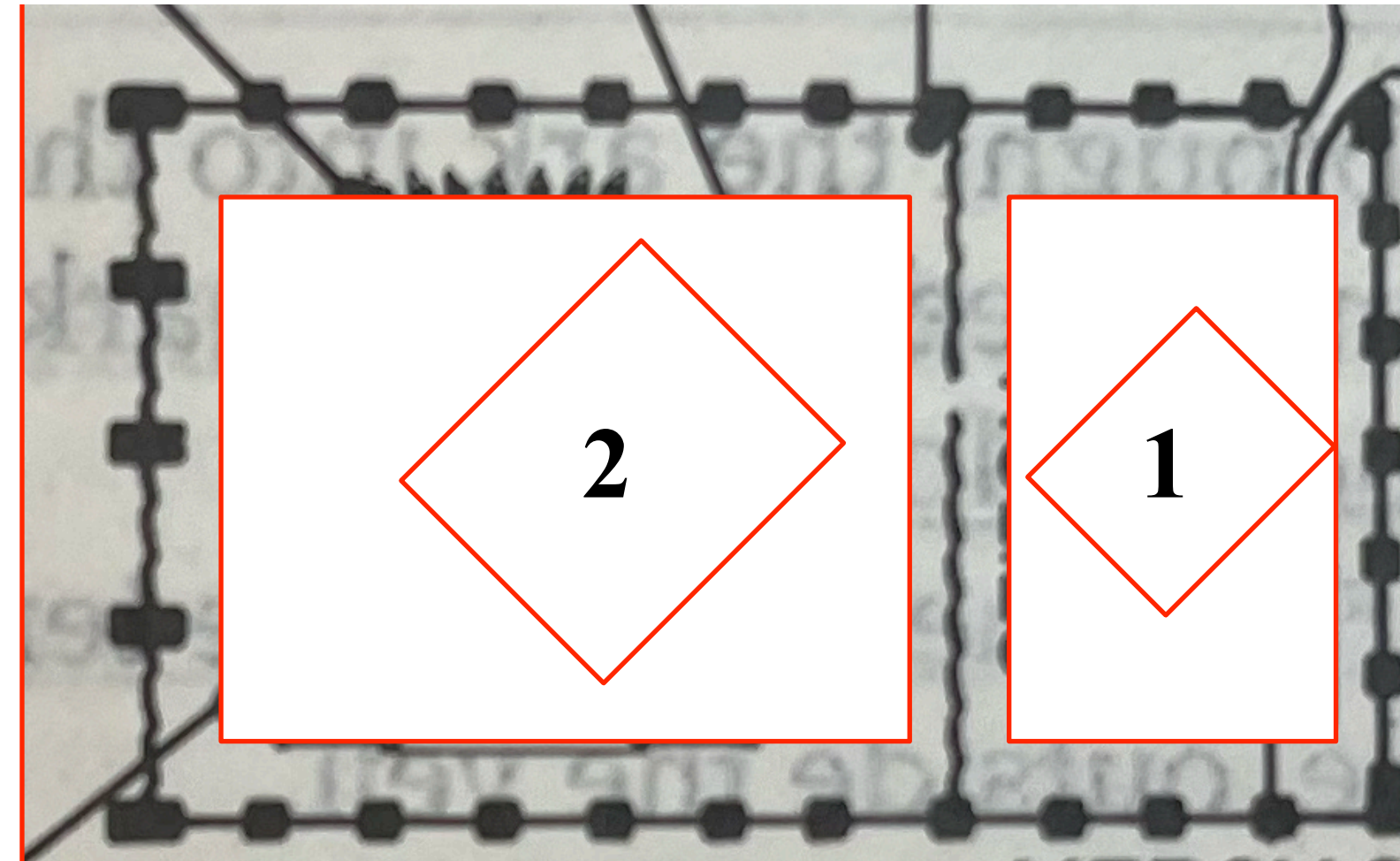
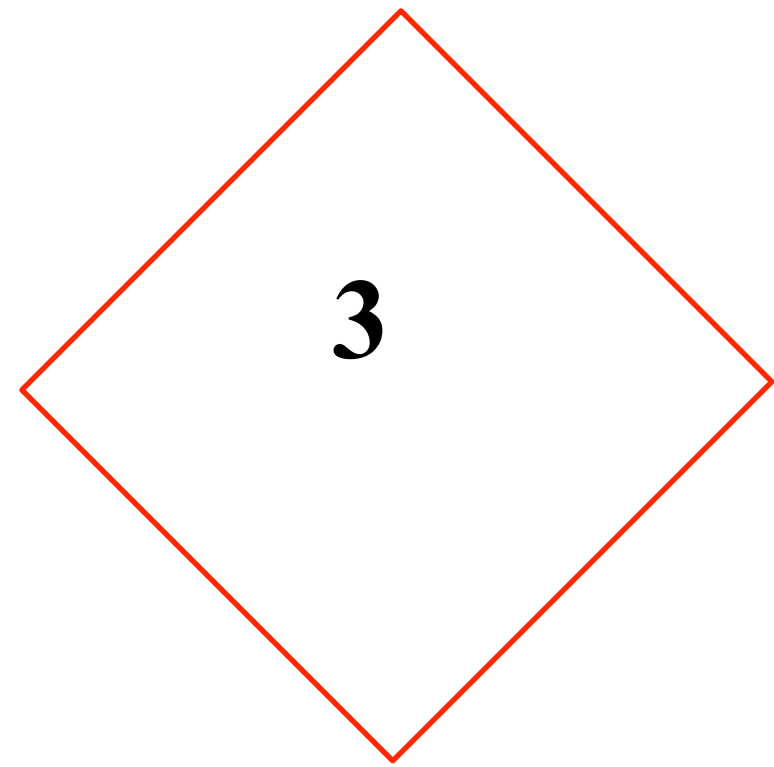
23. What were the two rooms in the tabernacle and what was the function of each room?
