Crisis Management Plans

1. What are Crisis Management Plans?

Business: A crisis management plan outlines how your business will react if a crisis occurs. The goal of a crisis management plan is to minimize damage and restore business operations as quickly as possible.

Personal: A plan of action that's made before a crisis occurs, so you and people in your support system know what to do when an emergency comes up.
