dictionary.com: 1) inclined to lustfulness; wanton. 2) arousing sexual desire. 3)indicating sexual interest or expressive of lust or lewdness.

Wantonness

dictionary.com: 4. sexually lawless or unrestrained; loose; lascivious; lewd: wanton behavior.

Lewdness

dictionary.com: 1) inclined to, characterized by, or inciting to lust or lechery; lascivious. 2) obscene or indecent, as language or songs; salacious.

Unrestrained and unlawful indulgence in sexual pleasures.

Definition of Other Sexual Words.

- 1. **immorality** = unlawful sexual act.
- 2. **impurity** = acts that lead or associated with immorality.
- 3. **passion** = whereas the first two words deal with deeds, this word reaches into the heart and deals with emotions.
- 4. <u>evil desire</u> = this word again searches the heart and has to do with intent. It is used of purposeful desire, to set ones heart upon something, and in this context, something immoral.
- 5. **greed** = once again the heart is examined; this time as to priorities. Desire for sexual pleasure that would override ones duty to God and crowd out spiritual priorities becomes a "god," and to devote one1s body, mind, energy.
- 6. **sexual promiscuity** = unlawful sexual relations.
- 7. <u>lust</u> = in setting of sexual sins, it is strong sexual desire for what is forbidden.
- 8. **adultery** = unlawful sexual intercourse, in which one or both participants, is bound by law to someone else.
