Examples of DisHonesty

Gen. 4:9

9 Then the LORD said to Cain, “Where is Abel your brother?” And he said, “I do not know. Am I my brother’s keeper?”

Gen. 12:13; 20:2

13 “Please say that you are my sister so that it may go well with me because of you, and that I may live on account of you.”

2 And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, “She is my sister.” So Abimelech king of Gerar sent and took Sarah.

Gen. 27:18-19

18 Then he came to his father and said, “My father.” And he said, “Here I am. Who are you, my son?”

19 And Jacob said to his father, “I am Esau your first-born; I have done as you told me. Get up, please, sit and eat of my game, that you may bless me.”

Examples of DisHonesty

2 Sam. 11:12-13

12 Then David said to Uriah, “Stay here today also, and tomorrow I will let you go.” So Uriah remained in Jerusalem that day and the next.

13 Now David called him, and he ate and drank before him, and he made him drunk; and in the evening he went out to lie on his bed with his lord’s servants, but he did not go down to his house.

Luke 10:25, 29

25 And behold, a certain lawyer stood up and put Him to the test, saying, “Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”

Examples of DisHonesty

Acts 5:1-3

1 But a certain man named **Ananias**, with his wife **Sapphira**, sold a piece of property,

2 and kept back some of the price for himself, with his wife's full knowledge, and bringing a portion of it, he laid it at the apostles' feet.

3 But Peter said, "**Ananias**, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit, and to keep back some of the price of the land?

Jam. 5:4

4 Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, and which has been withheld by you (rich men), cries out against you; and the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth."

I Pet. 4:3-4, 12-19

3 For the time already past is sufficient for you to have carried out the desire of the Gentiles, having pursued a course of sensuality, lusts, drunkenness, carousals, drinking parties and abominable idolatries.4 And in all this, they are surprised that you do not run with them into the same excess of dissipation, and they malign you;
