### **Drunkenness**

- 1. Strongs=3178,drunkenness.
- 2. Vines = "strong drink", denotes "drunkenness, habitual intoxication".
- 3. Thayers=1) intoxication 2) drunkenness.

### Carousing

- 1. Strongs=2970, a village festival, revel.
- 2. Vines="a revel, carousal," the concomitant and consequence of drunkenness. rendered "rioting" in Romans 13:13.

### Carousing

3. Thayers=1) a revel, carousal 1a) a nocturnal and riotous procession of half drunken and frolicsome fellows who after supper parade through the streets with torches and music in honour of Bacchus or some other deity, and sing and play before houses of male and female friends; hence used generally of feasts and drinking parties that are protracted till late at night and indulge in revelry.

#### I Pet. 4:3-5

3 For the time already past is sufficient for you to have carried out the desire of the Gentiles, having pursued a course of sensuality, lusts, drunkenness, carousals drinking parties and abominable idolatries.

4 And in all this, they are surprised that you do not run with them into the same excess of dissipation, and they malign you;

5 but they shall give account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. • Which three words refer to the consumption of intoxicating beverages.

### **Drunkenness**

- 1. Strongs=3632, drunkenness, debauchery.
- 2. Vines=an overflow (or surplus) of wine, that is, vinolency (drunkenness).
- 3. Thayers=1) drunkenness.

### **Drinking Parties**

- 1. Strongs=4224, a drinking bout.
- 2. Vines=lit., "a drinking," signifies not simply a banquet but "a drinking bout, a carousal,".
- 3. Thayers=1) a drinking, carousing.

#### **Destructive and Dangerous**

#### Pro. 23:29-35

29 Who has woe? Who has sorrow? Who has contentions? Who has complaining? Who has wounds without cause? Who has redness of eyes? 30 Those who linger long over wine, Those who go to taste mixed wine. 31 Do not look on the wine when it is red, When it sparkles in the cup, When it goes down smoothly; 32 At the last it bites like a serpent, And stings like a viper. 33 Your eyes will see strange things, And your mind will utter perverse things.

34 And you will be like one who lies down in the middle of the sea, Or like one who lies down on the top of a mast. 35 "They struck me, but I did not become ill; They beat me, but I did not know it. When shall I awake? I will seek another drink."

### **Example of Drunkedness**

### Gen. 19:31-35

31 Then the first-born said to the younger, "Our father is old, and there is not a man on earth to come in to us after the manner of the earth.

32 "Come, let us make our father drink wine, and let us lie with him, that we may preserve our family through our father."

33 So they made their father drink wine that night, and the first-born went in and lay with her father; and he did not know when she lay down or when she arose.

34 And it came about on the morrow, that the first-born said to the younger, "Behold, I lay last night with my father; let us make him drink 5. Where did Lot's daughters wine tonight also; then you go in and lie with him, that we may preserve our family through our father."

35 So they made their father drink wine that night also, and the younger arose and lay with him; and he did not know when she lay down or when she arose.

GOD'S SPECIAL PEOPLE NEED TO BE INFORMED AS TO WHAT THE BIBLE ACTUALLY TEACHES AND TO BE ON THE ALERT LEST THEY BE DUPED BY **DECEPTIVE ARGUMENT.**
