- 1. "occult" from Latin occultus, secret, or concealed.
- 2. Of, relating to, or dealing with supernatural influences, agencies, or phenomena."
- 3. "Occult suggests knowledge reputedly gained only by secret, magical, or supernatural means."

Definitions

4. "designating or of certain alleged mystic arts, such as magic, alchemy, astrology, etc."

a. "astrology" - "2. a pseudo-science claiming to foretell the future by studying the supposed influence of the relative positions of the moon, sun, and stars on human affairs."


5. "Matters regarded as involving the action or influence of supernatural or supernormal powers or some secret knowledge of them".

Ex. 7:11, 22

11 Then Pharaoh also called for the wise men and the sorcerers, and they also, the magicians of Egypt, did the same with their secret arts.

22 But the magicians of Egypt did the same with their secret arts; and Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he did not listen to them, as the LORD had said.

Ex. 8:7, 18-19

7 And the magicians did the same with their secret arts, making frogs come up on the land of Egypt.

18 And the magicians tried with their secret arts to bring forth gnats, but they could not; so there were gnats on man and beast.

19 Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, "This is the finger of God." But Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he did not listen to them, as the LORD had said. Compare definition of "occult."

a. "practices witchcraft" NKJV

b. 1. the act or practice of trying to foretell the future or the unknown by occult means.

3) "Witchcraft" -

a. "observer of times" KJV; "practiseth augury" ASV; "soothsayer" NKJV.

b. "augury" - "1. the practice of divination from omens.

4) "One who interprets omens" -

a. "omen" - "a thing or happening supposed to foretell a future event, either good or evil.

b. "enchanter" KJV, ASV.

c. "augur" - "1. in ancient Rome, any of a body of officials who interpreted omens as being favorable or unfavorable in connection with an undertaking.

5) **"Sorcerer".**

a. "witch" KJV; "engages in witchcraft" NIV

b. "sorcery" - "1. the supposed use of an evil supernatural power over people and their affairs.

- 6) "One who casts a spell".
 - a. "charmer" KJV, ASV

7) "**Medium" -**

a. "consulter with familiar spirits" KJV, ASV

b. "medium" - a person through whom communications are supposedly sent to the living from spirits of the dead"

8) "Spiritist" -

a. "wizard" KJV, ASV

b. "spiritism" - "spiritualism" - "1. a) the belief that the dead survive as spirits which can communicate with the living, esp. with the help of a third party (medium)
b) any practice arising from this belief".

9. "One who calls up the dead".

a. "necromancer" KJV, ASV, RSV; "consults the dead" NIV

b. "necromancy" - "1. the practice of claiming to foretell the future by alleged communication with the dead 2. black magic" W.NWD

Isa. 44:7, 24-28
