

“honor” - respect, esteem

- Why?

Duty based on relationship Ex 20:12;

Mal 1:6-8; Lev 19:3; Eph 6:1

Though imperfect Heb 12:9-10;

Gen 9:20-27; 1Tim 5:1-2

- Manifested in conduct, speech... Ex 21:15,17;

Lev 19:32; Pro 30:17; 1Tim 5:1,2

- Never seek revenge Job 31:29,30;

Rom 12:17,19-21; Pro 20:22; 24:29

“honor” ...?

- “hang out with”? **NO**. Visit if **NEED**? Yes.
- “indulge every whim”? **NO**. Provide, care for? Yes.
- fulfill wishes? **NO**. honor by life? **Pro 10:1; 1Co 10:31**
- act like perfect? **NO**. rebuke *respectfully*. **1Tim 5:1,2**
- say “wonderful” when not? **NO**. God’s prophets don’t!
- allow to abuse, sexually exploit, steal, without opposition, exposure? **NO**. *Do not enable by silence!*

Note Jonathan: **1Sam 19:10:2,4,6; 20:1-2...30-34**

“honor” ...?

- Must continue to rescue? **NO** Mt 7:6; 10:12-15...28-39
 - Have *feelings* of love, *want* company? **NO**. Caring love
 - Forgive them unconditionally? **NO**. If repent - YES
Lk 17:3; 1Jn 5:16b; Jer 7:16-17
- But, not mean should not care for them - Mt 5:44,45
