- Jesus left on own accord
- Someone else removed the body **NOT** the Jews...Romans...Soldiers...Roman rulers

NO SKEPTIC HAS EVER PROPOSED THAT THE BODY WAS STILL IN THE TOMB SUNDAY MORNING! Where's the body?

The grave clothes

Jn 20:6-7 - "he saw [theOreO - "careful observation of details"VN,TH] the linen wrappings lying there, and the face-cloth which had been on His head, not lying with the linen wrappings, but rolled up ["folded up" ESV; "arranged in orderly fashion" RWP] in a place by itself"

- Friends would not have removed them
- Thieves would not have left them orderly
- Neither had motive
