- *It's not* your music, *but* the volume.

“not...but” degree of comparison

Clear Bible Examples

- **Jn 6:27** “**not** work for the food which perishes, **but** for the food with endures”
- **I Sam 8:7** “**not** rejected you, **but** they have rejected Me”
- **Acts 5:4** “**not** lied to men **but** to God”

Passages where critical in interpretation

- **1Co 1:17** “**not** to baptize, **but** to preach”
- **Jam 5:12** “**not** swear, **but** let your yes be yes”
- **Heb 6:13,17; 2Co 1:23; Gal 1:20**
- **Heb 10:25** “**not** forsaking assembling, **but** encouraging one another”
- **1Pt 3:3,4** “**not** external, braid hair, wearing jewelry, put on dresses; **but** the hidden person”

Passages where critical in interpretation

- **Jn 5:30** “**not** seek my own will, **but** the will of Him who sent Me” **6:38; 7:16; 12:48,49**

Mt 26:39 “**not** as I will, **but** as you will”

- **Heb 10:5,8-10** came to die
- **Mt 20:22; Jn 18:11** before and after
- **Mt 26:42** “cannot pass away unless I drink it”
He did...it did!
- **Heb 12:2** “for the joy set before him, endured the cross...sat down at right hand of God”

Lk 12:4,5
