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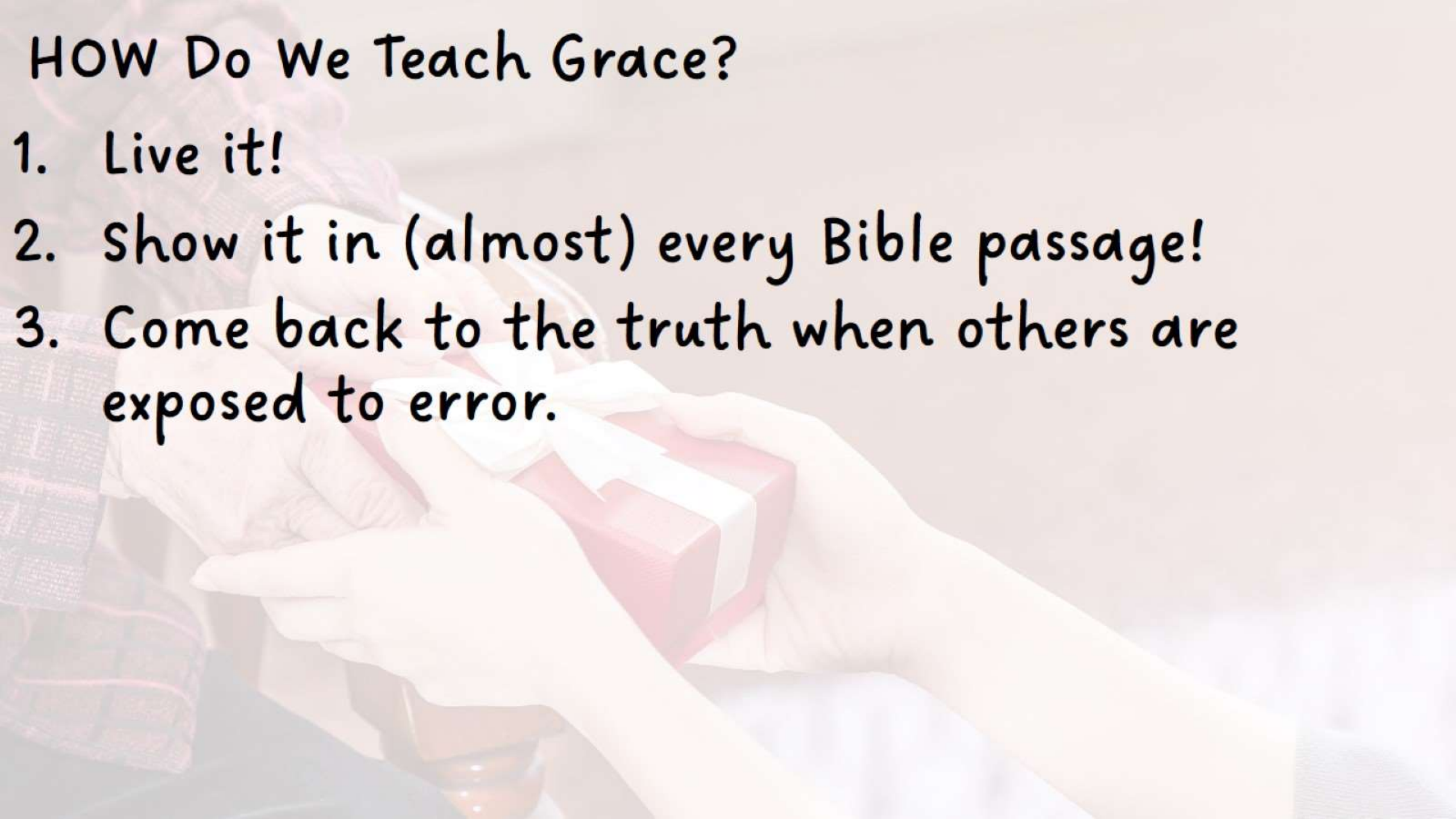
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    2. Encourage them to talk to/question and LISTEN to their friends, and then talk to you.
