Hosea: A Story of Judgment and Love

Background

- prophet to Israel (northern kingdom)
- c.755-725 B.C.
- Contemporary of Isaiah and Micah
- Works just after the prophet Amos
- Fulfillment: 722 B.C. by Assyria. End of northern kingdom

Major Themes

- God's love for His people despite their "harlotry"
- God's righteous judgment and wrath against His people.
- God is a jealous God! (Dt. 6:13-15)
- Repent!

Why is the LORD angry w/Israel?

- Sought after material things/wealth instead of God
- Mixing with nations
- IDOLATRY
- Other sins
- Theme: they have forgotten God
- Prideful despite habitual sin

What will the LORD do?

Judge them fairly!

More imagery of judgment

What did the LORD require to fix this problem?

- REPENT!
- Get back to serving the one, true God
