

Jn 8:1-11

- ★ v4 - “Adultery” an “act”
- ★ v6 - Jesus knows *dishonesty*
Mk 2:8; Jn 2:24; 4:17-18...39
- ★ Jesus condemns *hypocrisy* just as He does *immorality*
 - vv7 - “without sin” ...*any?...this?* (Mt 5:27,28)?...*unrepented of* (Mt 7:1)? ...v9!

NOT teach ... *Wrong to rebuke for sin*

- Mt 15:3; 23:1f - Jesus
- Ac 5:3,4; 8:20; 13:9-10 - Apostles
- Mt 18:15-17; Tit 1:9,13 - Christians

NOT teach ... *Unloving to rebuke*

- “love” *in text?*
- 2Co 2:4; Rev 3:19
- Pro 3:12; 13:24 - parental mistake

NOT teach...*Sin OK (“Grace vs. law”)*

- **v11** - “I do not condemn you either” ...?
As **LAWGIVER** and **JUDGE** he had the authority to forgive her. *We do not.*
- **Mt 5:27-32; 1Co 6:9,10** *Adultery IS condemned!*
- **Jn 8:11** *“Sin no more!”*

NOT teach...*Sin OK (“Grace vs. law”)*

- 1Pt 5:12... 1:14-19; 4:1-3; Jude4; Rm 6:1

The truth about God’s grace

- 1Co 5:4-5; 2Th 3:6 *NT - withdraw*

- Mt 5:29; 24:51; 25:41,46 *Eternity - HELL!*
