These women were Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, Salome, Joanna and possibly other un-named women.

3. The women come to the grave site and were wondering who would roll away the large stone. When they arrived the stone was already removed and they entered the tomb and found the body missing.

5. Two angels appear to the other women at grave site. One of the angels was sitting to the right wearing a white robe. The other wore dazzling apparel. The women were told not be afraid. The angels tell them He is not here but has arisen. Remember they said that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and rise again on the third day. The women remembered Jesus' words. They are instructed to go tell the Apostles that He has arisen and He is going before them to Galilee. The women run quickly to report to the Apostles: trembling, astonished, afraid, joyful but said nothing to each other.

The face-cloth which had been on His head was not lying with the other linen wrappings but rolled up in a place by itself. Peter finally enters the tomb. They both believe that the body is missing but still did not believe He has risen. They leave and go back to their homes.

If this incident comes to the governors knowledge, these leaders would convince him and keep the soldiers from trouble. This story was widely spread among the Jews.

12. On the first day, two of Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ were walking to a town called Emmaus which is seven miles from Jerusalem. 14. As these 2 disciples were talking to the Apostles behind \_\_\_\_\_ for fear of the Jews, Jesus appears to them. They were startled and frightened and thought Jesus was a \_\_\_\_\_. He asks them why they are troubled and doubt in His appearance. He \_\_\_\_\_ them for their \_\_\_\_\_ based on the reports that He had risen. He says see My \_\_\_\_\_ and My \_\_\_\_\_, it is me. Touch Me and see for a spirit does not have flesh and bones.

# The Narrative

14. As these 2 disciples were talking to the Apostles behind closed doors for fear of the Jews, Jesus appears to them. They were startled and frightened and thought Jesus was a ghost. He asks them why they are troubled and doubt in His appearance. He rebukes them for their unbelief based on the reports that He had risen. He says see My hands and My feet, it is me. Touch Me and see for a spirit does not have flesh and bones.

# The Narrative

14. The disciples therefore rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them — "*Peace be with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you.*" And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and \*said to them, "*Receive the \_\_\_\_\_.*" If you forgive the \_\_\_\_\_ of any, their \_\_\_\_\_ have been forgiven them; if you retain the \_\_\_\_\_ of any, they have been retained."

# The Narrative

14. The disciples therefore rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them — *"Peace be with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you."* And when He had said this, He *breathed on them, and \*said to them, "Receive the **Holy Spirit**.* *"If you forgive the **sins** of any, their **sins** have been forgiven them; if you retain the **sins** of any, they have been retained."*

14. Jesus then says He is \_\_\_\_\_ and asks them if they have anything to eat. They give him some \_\_\_\_\_ and He eats it. \_\_\_\_\_ was not present during this appearance. The other disciples told Thomas they have seen the Lord and he would not \_\_\_\_\_. “*Unless I shall \_\_\_\_\_ in His hands the imprint of the nails, and \_\_\_\_\_ my finger into the place of the nails, and \_\_\_\_\_ my hand into His side, I will not \_\_\_\_\_*”.

# The Narrative

14. Jesus then says He is hungry and asks them if they have anything to eat. They give him some boiled fish and He eats it. Thomas was not present during this appearance. The other disciples told Thomas they have seen the Lord and he would not believe. *“Unless I shall see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe”*.
