Objectives

- Learn some lessons.
- Deepen our faith in JC Resurrection.

Lessons

1. How many reports did the Apostles receive/experience either about His Body missing or has arisen and yet they still did not believe? List the person(s) and what was reported.

1) Mary Magdalene: body missing (John 20:2).

2) Women: Jesus has Arisen from Angels (Matt. 28:8, Luke 24:9-11).

3) Peter/John: At grave site, body missing (Luke 24:12, John 20:3-10).

Lessons

4) Mary Magdalene: Jesus has Arisen from Jesus Appearance (Mark 16:9-11, John 20:11-18).

5) Women: Jesus has Arisen from Jesus Appearance (Matt. 28:9-10).

6) Peter: Jesus has Arisen from Jesus Appearance (Luke 24:34, 1Cor. 15:5).

Lessons

7). Two Disciples(Cleopas / un-named): Jesus has Arisen from Jesus Appearance (Mark 16:12, Luke 24:13-32).

2. Why did the Apostles not believe after all these reports/experiences?

Hardness of Heart. Mark 16:14

Lessons

3. How many separate appearances did Jesus make on the 1st day?

5 (Mary Magdalene, women, 2 Disciples, Peter, Apostles w/o Thomas).

Lessons

4. Contrast the faith between the women and men disciples. Make a list of actions of the women and men.

Women

- At crucifixion & observed grave site.
- Had spices already prepared.
- Organized & went to the grave.
- Stone would be removed.
- Confront the Roman Guard.
- Actively informing the Apostles.
- Body was missing, not raised.

Men

- Only John at the cross.
- Peter & John at grave site, did not believe.
- Peter & John go back to homes.
- Did not believe after all reports.
- Peter's lack of action after appearance.
- Two Disciples great faith.
- Apostles behind closed doors, fearful.

Lessons

5. List the different types of evidences presented on the first day proving Jesus was resurrected as a human being and not a spirit or an apparition.

Lessons

- 1) 5 physical appearances
(1+3+2+10 = 16+ people).
- 2) Empty tomb, missing body.
- 3) Tomb sealed with Roman Guard.
- 4) Roman Guard was paid off.
- 5) Rational discussions.
- 6) Teaching class.
- 7) Breaking bread, eating broiled fish.

Lessons

6. How many times did Jesus tell His Apostles about his death and resurrection?

1. After Peter's Confession
(Matt. 16:21-28, Mark 8:31-9:1, Luke 9:22).
2. After Healing Demoniac Boy
(Matt. 17:22-23, Mark 9:30-32, Luke 9:44-45).
3. After Discussion with Rich Young Ruler
(Matt. 20. 17-19, Mark 10:32-34, Luke 18:31-34).
4. Cleansing the Temple the First Time
(John 2:22).
5. Golden Verse of the Bible
(John 3:14-16).
6. Discourse on Light of the World
(John 8:28).
7. Talking to Greeks
(John 12:23-36).

Lessons

7. Jesus told His Apostles that they would forgive sins (John 20:21-23). How is this possible since only God can forgive sins?

Figure of Speech: **effect** mentioned but the **cause** meant. The sins would be forgiven by God (**effect**) by their preaching the Gospel of Salvation (**cause**). Acts 2:38.

2 Disciples on road to Emmaus

9. How many different angel appearances on the first day?

3 (Roman Guard, women (minus Mary Magdalene), Mary Magdalene).

Lessons

10. What do we know about the 4 named woman at the grave site?

Mary Magdalene: At the cross, leader of the women, went to anoint body of Jesus, Lord appeared to first, Jesus cleansed 7 demons from her, special discussion with her after resurrection, reports missing body & appearance to Peter & John.

Lessons

Mary Mother of James & Joseph: At the cross, went to anoint body of Jesus, Jesus appeared to her, early disciple of JC.

Salome: Sister of Mary, the Lord's mother, mother of James & John, went to anoint body of Jesus, Jesus appeared to her.

Lessons

Joanna: Went to anoint body of Jesus, Jesus appeared to her, wife of Chuza, Herod's steward, contributing support to Jesus and the Apostles during their ministry.
