

- 1. in Bethany beyond the Jordan. (1:28): <u>Place east of Jordan River where John Baptist</u> <u>was baptizing. Located NE of Dead Sea.</u>
- 2. Galilee (1:43,4:3,43,45,47,7:1,9,41,52(2x)): Northern Region of Palestine.
- 3. Bethsaida (1:44,12:21): <u>Town of Galilee. Home town of Philip, Andrew and Peter. Located on NE shore of Sea of Galilee.</u>
- 4. Nazareth (1:45,46,18:5): <u>Town of Galilee where Joseph and Mary lived and where Jesus grew up. Located 15 miles west-southwest of Tiberias.</u>
- 5. Cana of Galilee (2:1,11,4:46,54,21:2): Where the wedding occurred that Jesus attended. Located 4 miles NE Nazareth.
- 6. Capernaum (2:12,4:46,6:17,24,59): <u>City located on NW shore of Sea of Galilee. Home location of Jesus' Galilean Ministry (Mk. 2:1).</u>
- 7. Jerusalem (2:13,23,4:20,21,45,10:22,11:18,55,12:12): Capital of Judea. Located E-W line from Dead to Mediterranean Sea, 1/3 from Dead Sea.
- 8. The wilderness (3:14,6:49): The wilderness where the Israelites wandered for 40 years.
- 9. Land of Judea (2:22,4:47,54,): Southern Region of Palestine.
- 10. Aenon near Salim (3:23): <u>Place where John the Baptist was baptizing because there was much water there. Located west of Jordan River, 27 miles south of Sea of Galilee.</u>
- 11. Samaria (4:4,7,9(2x),): Central Region of Palestine, land of mixed race of Jews/Gentiles.
- 12. Sychar (4:5): Town of Samaria, near Jacob's well, located between Mt. Ebal & Mt. Gerizim.
- 13. This mountain (4:20): Probably Mount Gerizim at the foot of which Sychar was situated.
- 14. Sheep gate (5:2): <u>Located on the north side of the Jerusalem where the sheep were brought into the temple for sacrifices.</u>
- 15. Bethesda(5:2): A pool at Jerusalem which was near the sheep gate and had five porches. Its waters are supposed to possess healing powers.
- 16. Sea of Galilee or Tiberias (6:2,17,18,21:1): Sea located in Galilee.
- 17. The mountain (6:3,15): This mountain may be in the desert of Bethsaida on the NE corner of the Sea of Galilee, overlooking the sea. See also Mark 3:13, Matt. 5:1, Matt. 14:23.
- 18. Other side of the sea (6:22,25): Near Capernaum on the shores of Sea of Galilee.
- 19. Tiberias (6:23): City on Sea of Galilee, located on south-western shore.
- 20. Bethlehem (7:42): Birth place of Jesus, 5 miles south of Jerusalem.
- 21. Mount of Olives(8:1): Hill east of Jerusalem separated by the Valley of Kidron.
- 22. Pool of Siloam(9:7,11): Pool at Jerusalem near the King's Garden located in southern part of the city.
- 23. Portico of Solomon(10:23): A portico built by Solomon, on the east side of the outer court of the temple.
- 24. Beyond the Jordon(10:40): Probably same place as in Bethany beyond the Jordan (#1).
- 25. Bethany(11:1,18,12:1,): <u>City of Martha, Mary, Lazarus. 2 Miles East of Jerusalem on the Road to Jericho.</u>
- 26. Country near the Wilderness(11:54): <u>Wilderness, extended from Jericho to Bethel (Jos 16:1), called the wilderness of Bethaven (Jos 18:12), in which Joshua and the Israelites slew the inhabitants of Ai. (Jos 8:24.).</u>
- 27. Ephraim(11:54): <u>City near the wilderness where Jesus fled to. Located 8 miles north of</u> Jerusalem.
- 28. Ravine of the Kidron(18:1): Valley east of Jerusalem.

- 29. Garden(18:1): <u>Gethsemane where olives grew and were cultivated</u>. <u>East of Jerusalem at the foot of Mount Olives</u>. <u>Jesus went there before being arrested</u>.
- 30. Praetorium(18:28(2x),33): Palace of Pontius Pilate at Jerusalem where the judgment seat was erected.
- 31. Place of a Skull(19:17): Common name for Golgotha. Side of hill has rocks that look like a skull.
- 32. Golgotha(19:17): Place where Jesus was crucified, outside the city walls of Jerusalem, located northwest of the city. Greek from Aramaic gulgalta, Hebrew gulgoleth, skull. Located near a highway. Likely, name given by the cranial shape of the rock i.e. like a skull.
- 33. Arimathea(19:38): City of Judea. Home town of Joseph of Arimathea who requested the body of Jesus. Located 25 miles NW of Jerusalem.
- 34. The tomb(20:8,11): Tomb of Joseph of Arimathea where Jesus was buried. Near Golgotha.
