- **Only One (God Incarnate) to Carry out God's Redemptive Plan.**

- Those Jews who had believed Him.

What they believed about Jesus is unknown but clearly it was not a true belief of who Jesus is.

Q12.3 What is the truth?

Jesus is God, He provides spiritual life and need to believe to access this life.

Q12.4 Did the Jews understand what is means to be free according to Jesus?

No.

Q12.5 What does Jesus mean to be enslaved?

Slave to sin.

Q12.6 How are we a slave to sin?

Doing the bidding of the devil and
will reap the eternal
consequences of sin.

Q12.7 In vs. 35 what is the house? What is the message in vs. 35 & 36?

Parallel Terms, vs. 35

- **Slave** || **Son.**
- **Does not remain** || **Does remain.**
- **House** || **House.**
- **Temporary** || **Forever.**

Q12.7 In vs. 35 what is the house? What is the message in vs. 35 & 36?

- House = fellowship with God.
- A new dispensation will come with the Son providing freedom from sin (i.e. its consequences).

Q12.8 Who do they
say their father is?

Abraham.

Q12.9 What are the deeds of Abraham?

Deeds of faith in obeying God.

Q12.10 How would the people do the deeds of Abraham?

By acting like Abraham, they would believe Jesus is God and do the things He says.

Q12.11 What is the truth Jesus told them?

He is God and provides spiritual life.

Q12.12 If God was
their Father, what would
they do?

They would believe, love and
obey Jesus.

Q12.13 How could
they not hear Jesus?

Hear is put for believing in Him.

Q12.14 What is their problem?

They are capable but are
unwilling.

Q12.15 He states in vs. 44,
their Father is the devil. How
is the Devil their Father?

It is by their actions.

Q12.16 Why did they
say He was a [REDACTED]
Samaritan in vs. 48?

Slander Him.

Q12.17 What does Jesus mean when He says anyone who keeps His Word shall never see death?

They would not receive spiritual death.

Q12.18 Do the people
understand this statement?

No.

Q12.19 In vs. 58, which of the 3 attributes in 1:1 does this refer to?

First one, “In the Beginning was the Word”, His eternal nature.
