

65. What are the deeds of Abraham in Chap. 8?

Deeds of faith in obeying God.

66. How would the people do the deeds of Abraham?

By acting like Abraham, they would believe Jesus is God and do the things He says.

Parallel Terms, vs. 35

- Slave | Son.
- Does not remain | Does remain.
- House House.
- Temporary Forever.

- House = fellowship with God.
- A new dispensation will come with the Son providing freedom from sin (i.e. its consequences).

24. What are the 3 parts of the message ("Word")?

- 1. Word is Deity vs. 1, 14.
- 2. Word provides Spiritual Life vs. 4, 12.
- 3. Believing in the Word provides

 Spiritual Life vs. 7, 12.

27. Why would the Jews ask if John the Baptist was Elijah (Mal.4:5) in Chapter 1?

A recent prophecy (Mal. 4:5) mention Elijah would return before the coming of the Lord.

41. Now, what does the phrase to be "born of the Spirit" mean?

Experience a new spiritual life.

54. What is the Work of God in 6:29?

Believe in Him.

63. Why is this important to know who Jesus is?

If people do not believe in Jesus, they will die in their sins.

Q13.1 What is a "work of God"?

Work that God performs.

Q13.2 So what is Jesus implying?

He is God.

Q13.3 What is the meaning of light of the World?

Shows the way to eternal life.

Q13.4 Were these steps necessary for Jesus to heal him?

No.

Q13.5 What do you think the natural reaction would be for this occasion?

Be rejoicing.

Q13.6 Could they be doubters in Jesus as the Son of God causing their questioning?

Likely.

Q13.7 Did Jesus violate the Sabbath?

There is no violation of OT Law.

Q13.8 Should not the Pharisees be rejoicing that this man is healed?

Yes.

Q13.9 What argument do they present?

This man was never blind to start with.

Q13.10 What would cause one to deny the obvious and make up a false charge?

The Will, 7:17.

Q13.11 Is the parents statement true, they do not know how this happened?

No.

Q13.12 Is this true in vs. 29 that they do not know where Jesus is from?

Knew He said He was from God but they did not believe.

Q13.13 What argument does the healed man present about Jesus?

He is a prophet.

Q13.14 What happens to the man?

Put out of the synagogue.

Q13.15 What is the implication of man worshipping Jesus?

Believes He was the Son of God deserving to be worshipped.

Q13.16 What does vs. 39 mean? Who are those who see?

- •Those who do not see = ignorant, good honest hearts, believe in Jesus.
- •Those who see = believe have fellowship with Father, closed hearts, do not believe in Jesus.
