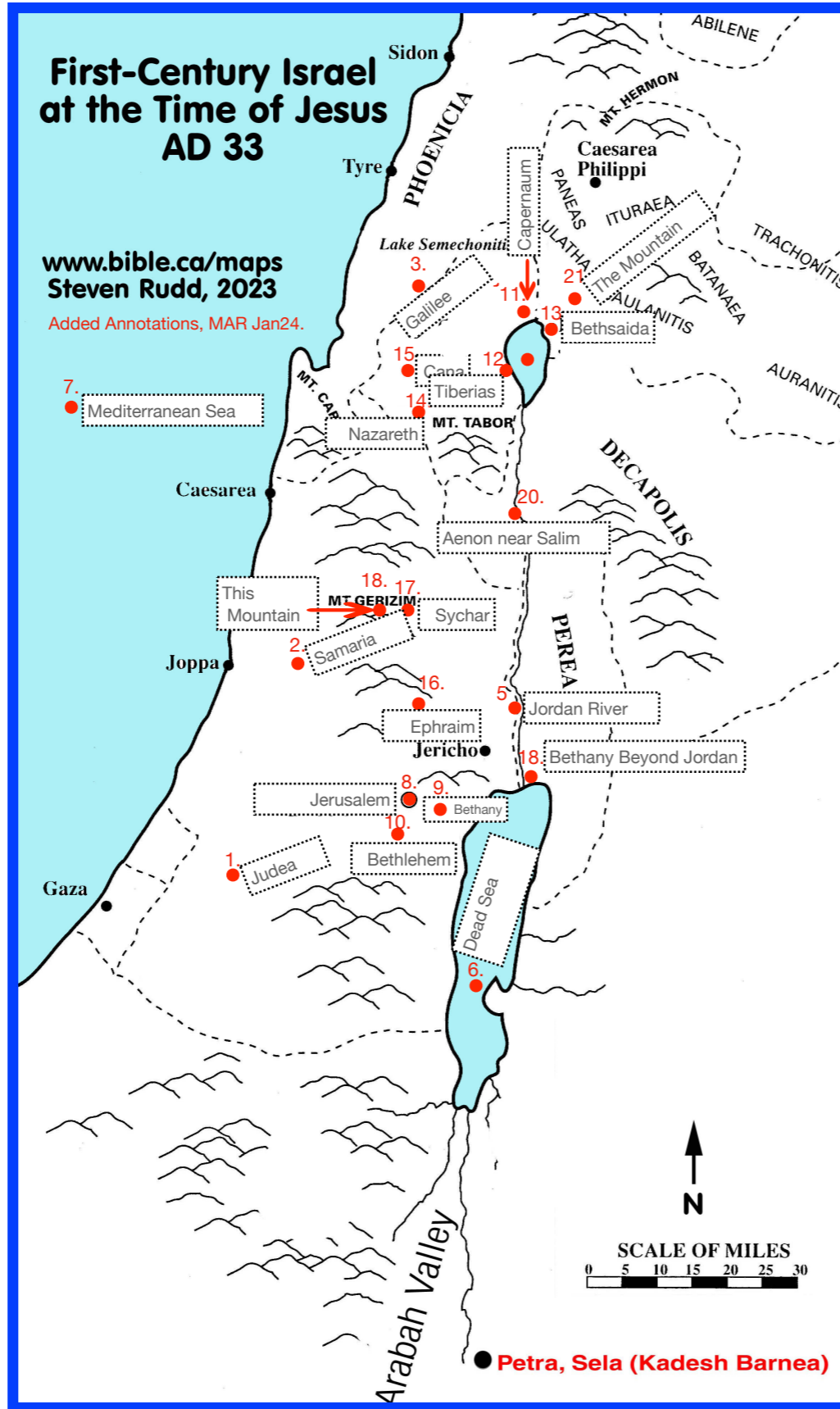


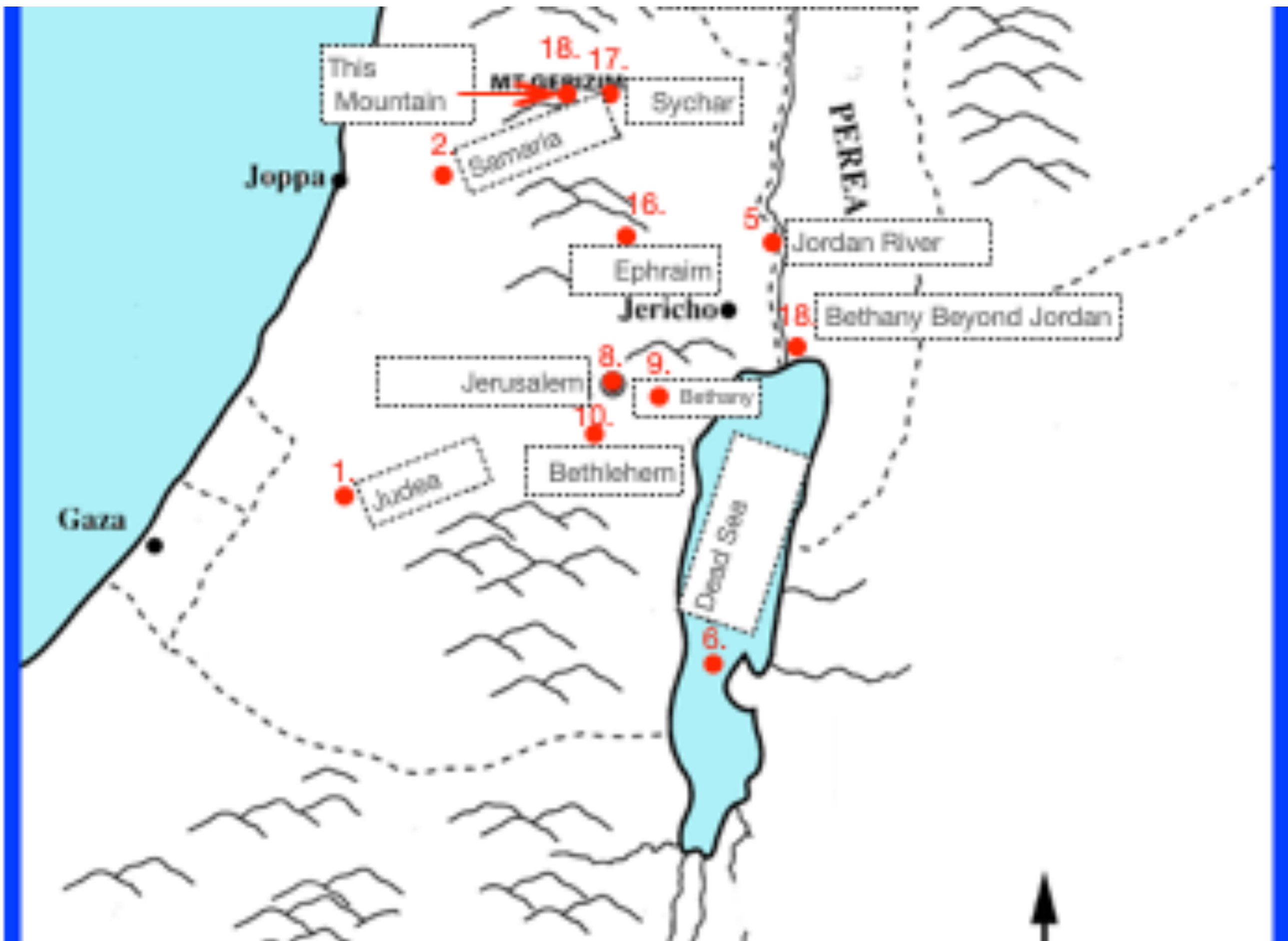
# Map 1

**Q15.1** Is the anointing of Jesus feet by Mary the same incident in Luke 7:36-38? Is this anointing here referred to again in the Gospel of John.

- No.
- Another anointing earlier in Jesus Ministry by a sinner.
- Yes. John 12.

**Q15.2** Jesus says this sickness is not unto death but Lazarus died. Was Jesus mistaken?

No. Not|But idiom. The emphasis is Lazarus sickness and final death would show the Son of God glorified.

**Q15.3** Why did He not come right away but waited 2 more days?

Again, raising Lazarus from the dead would glorify Him.

**Q15.4** Jesus says Lazarus has fallen asleep in vs. 11. Why did He say this when Lazarus was dead?

Possibly to show raising him from the dead was as easy as awakening him from the dead.

**Q15.5** Why did Jesus say  
— He was glad that He  
was not there when  
Lazarus was near death?

They may believe.

**Q15.6** In vs. 19, the Jews had come to comfort Martha and Mary. Where were these Jews the Jewish Leaders?

Likely not.



**Q15.7** Does Martha have faith in Jesus to do what He wishes?

- Yes.

**Q15.8** What does this statement mean when Jesus tells her, “I am the resurrection and the life”?

He is the one who causes the resurrection of the physical body and He is the one who provide spiritual life.

**Q15.9** What requirement of obtaining this spiritual life?

Believe in Me.

**Q15.10** What precisely does believing in Me entail?

1). Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, 2) provides spiritual life and 3) believe this to access.
