

73. Why did Jesus say— He was glad that He was not there when Lazarus was near death?


They may believe.

74. What does this statement mean when Jesus tells her, "I am the resurrection and the life"?


He is the one who causes the resurrection of the physical body and He is the one who provide spiritual life.
