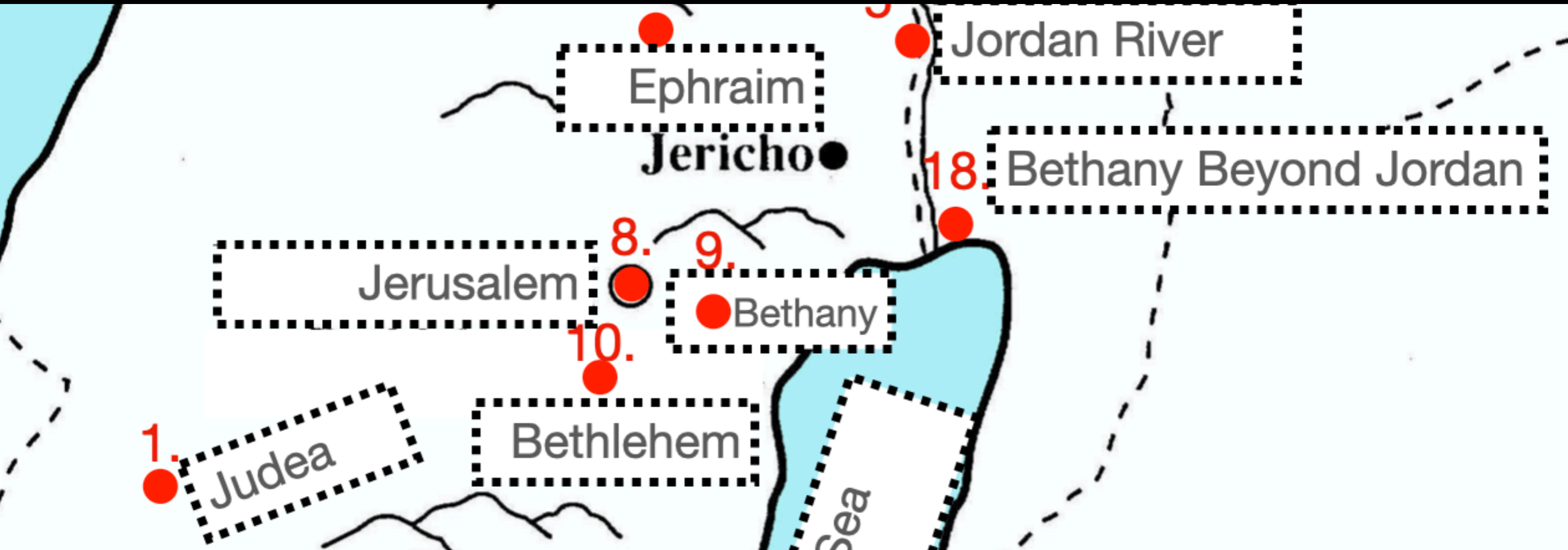

John 11

1. Jesus is in Bethany Beyond Jordan (Perea): 10:40.
2. Sisters send messengers to Jesus, "sent to Him": 11:3.
3. Jesus tells messengers sickness ==> glory of God: 11:4. Evidently, messengers return to sisters and relay message.

4. Jesus starts to travel to Bethany:
11:7.

5. Martha goes to meet Jesus,
Mary stays home: 11:20. Martha
meets Jesus somewhere between
the 2 Bethany's.

6. Martha goes back home to tell
Mary: 11:28.

7. Mary goes to Jesus and meets Him where He met Martha:
11:29-30. Some location between the 2 Bethany's.
8. Then Jesus goes to the tomb:
11:34.

Q16.4 In vs. 11:40, did Jesus say this directly to Martha and Mary according to the written record?

No.

35. In vs. 2:4, is Jesus saying His time is not ready to perform miracles by stating “My hour has not yet come” (7:30, 12:23, 17:1)? If so why did He perform a miracle?

- No.
- My hour is used in this gospel to refer to his death, burial and resurrection, 7:30, 12:23, 17:1.

1). Hearing the gospel not mentioned. Required?

2). Baptism (born of water) is required to enter Kingdom of God (vs. 5)

44. Some believe that John 3:16 shows that baptism is not required for salvation since it is not mentioned. How do you respond with this statement?

3). Example of Moses lifting up serpent shows that “believes” requires action.

4). Harmony of Scriptures (Mark 16:15-26, Acts 2:38, 22:16) requires that “believes” is a figure of speech known as synechode (a part is mentioned but whole is meant).

5). Apostle John taught baptism was required for salvation i.e. remission of sins, Acts 2:38.

The Law stated that no working i.e. earning a living should be performed on the Sabbath.

- Friday.

Q17.3 What chapters and verses cover the Passion Week in the Gospel of John?

12:12-20:23, Discourse with Apostles, ch. 13-17, 18-19 trials & crucifixion, 20:1-25 Resurrection.

Q17.4 What was the purpose of the anointing?

Preparation for Jesus burial.

Q17.5 How did she know
He would die and then be
buried?

Remember she was at Jesus
feet listening to His teaching.

Q17.6 What does this anointing say about Mary's faith?

She had a deep faith.

Q17.7 What was the real reason Judas objected to using this costly perfume?

- Wanted to pilfer the money.

Q17.8 Was it not Mary's funds that bought the perfume?

Yes.

Q17.9 How would he
get the money?

If the perfume was sold as he
stated, he might get the funds to
put in the money box.

Q17.10 Do the other
gospels reveal the person
and his motives?

No.

Q17.11 What does
Hosanna mean?

An Exclamation of adoration.

Q17.12 What does
blessed mean?

Praise.

Q17.13 Vs. 13 quotes Ps.
118:26. Is this Psalm
Messianic?

Yes.

Q17.14 When was Jesus glorified?

Raised from the dead.

Q17.15 How did they know about Jesus?

Jesus miracles were well known throughout Palestine and possibly beyond.

Q17.16 Why did they
come to Phillip first?

Maybe due interpersonal skills?

Q17.17 What is His hour?

His suffering, crucifixion, death and resurrection.

Q17.18 What is the implication about the grain of wheat?

He has to die to bear fruit i.e. the salvation of mankind.

Q17.19 What does vs. 25 mean?

Our priorities should be to put Christ first above worldly pursuits, result = eternal life.

Q17.20 What does the
Father honoring Jesus
servants imply in vs. 26?

Fellowship with the Father.
