The Law stated that no working i.e. earning a living should be performed on the Sabbath.

53. The third Passover is mentioned in 6:4. Remember the second Passover was mentioned in 5:1. Considering the events between these two Passovers, what does this tell us about the Gospel of John?

Not meant to record a significant portions of Jesus Ministry.

54. What is the Work of God in
6:29?

Believe in Him.

55. In vs. 6:30, they ask for a sign. Has enough signs been provided for them to believe? What signs have already been provided?

- Yes.
- Turning water into wine, healing Royal Official's son, feeding 5,000, walking on water, 10 miracles after the Sermon on the Mount.

56. What does “true bread” mean?

This new bread is “true” in that it provides eternal life.

57. What does it mean in vs. 6:53 to “eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drinks His blood”?

Believe in Him.

58. In vs. 8:51, it says Jesus is “living” bread. What does that mean?

He provides life forever.

59. Who arises to the occasion to defend Jesus in Chapter 7? What was he charged to do?

Nicodemus. Search the Scripture to see if Messiah was to come from Galilee.

60. What were their motives in the Pharisee bringing a woman caught in adultery?

- Evil, testing Him in order to accuse Him.

61. In vs. 8:12, Jesus says He is the Light of the World. What does this mean?

He provides the light(knowledge) which leads to eternal life (light of life).

62. When Jesus says “*I am not judging anyone*” in 8:15, does this mean Jesus is not our Judge?

Not/but idiom. His judgment, His witness is true and the Heavenly Father also bears witness of Him.

63. Why is this important to know who Jesus is (8:24)?

If people do not believe in Jesus, they will die in their sins.

64. How is possible that the people could believe who Jesus is but the Pharisees could not?

A matter of the will.

65. What are the deeds of Abraham in Chap. 8?

Deeds of faith in obeying God.

By acting like Abraham, they would believe Jesus is God and do the things He says.

- The good shepherd lays down His life for His sheep.

71. In vs. 10:30 He states “I and the Father are one”. How did this statement impact the Jewish Leaders?

Provoked them, wanted to kill Him.

72. Jesus says this sickness is not unto death but Lazarus died. Was Jesus mistaken?

No. Not|But idiom. The emphasis is Lazarus sickness and final death would show the Son of God glorified.

was near death?

They may believe.

74. What does this statement mean when Jesus tells her, “I am the resurrection and the life”?

He is the one who causes the resurrection of the physical body and He is the one who provide spiritual life.

Believe in Me.

12:12-20:25, Discourse with Apostles, ch. 13-17, 18-19 trials & crucifixion, 20:1-25 Resurrection.

Preparation for Jesus burial.

79. What was the real reason Judas objected to using this costly perfume?

- Wanted to pilfer the money.

80. How does John summarize these rulers who believed but did not confess Him in Chapter 12?

Loved the approval of man rather than the approval of God.

81. What was the purpose of prophesying Judas betrayal?

To believe in Jesus as the Messiah, Son of God and understand He came to provide spiritual life.

82. What does this mean in vs. 27 that Satan entered Judas?

Exerted some influence and Judas gave in.

83. What peace is this in
14:27?

Peace would be obtained thru Holy Spirit and Jesus words of comfort and support to carry out their mission.

84. What are the 4 pieces in the analogy about the physical vine?

- The vine.
- The branches.
- The fruit.
- The vinedresser.

85. Who does each part of the analogy represent?

Jesus is the vine.

The apostles are the branches.

The Father is the vinedresser.

86. What is the fruit?

Apostles carry on their mission to preach the Gospel and its resultant accomplishments.

87. What are the 3 things that the Holy Spirit would convict the world?

Sin, Righteousness, Judgment.

The truth i.e. who is Jesus and
why He came to this world.

With Jesus at trial.

90. Where is the trial before Caiaphas and the Sanhedrin Council recorded in the Gospel of John (Q24.9)?

Not recorded.

91. How many times will Pilate say “I find no guilt in Him” (Q25.3)?

- 3 times [18:38, 19:4, 6].

92. What made Pilate afraid during Jesus trial (Q25.4)?

When the chief priests say made himself out to be the Son of God..

Review

93. How do the Jewish Leaders finally convince Pilate to crucify Jesus (Q25.6)?

Not recorded.

Review

94. What objection does the chief priests make about the inscription on the cross (Q25.8)?

- They wanted the inscription to read, “I am King of the Jews.”.

Review

95. Why would Jesus ask He is thirsty right before His death (Q25.12)?

To fulfill Scripture.

Review

96. What 2 men were involved in His burial (Q25.16)?

Joseph of Arimathea,
Nicodemus.

Review

97. When John was in the tomb and looked, the text say he believed. What did he believe (Q26.5)?

- The tomb was empty.

Review

99. How can the Apostles forgive sins as recorded in 20:23 (Q26.12)?

Only God can forgive sins. By their preaching and people responding to the gospel message, God can forgive sins.

Review

100. Does Jesus expect people to believe in Him because others says so as in the case of Thomas (Q26.13)?

No.

Q26.5 When John was in the tomb and looked, the text says he believed. What did he believe?

The tomb was empty.

inspiration referring to?

- Unsure.

Q26.7 Was this the first or second time she was at the tomb on the first day?

Second time.

Q26.8 Why did Jesus
choose to appear to
Mary first?

Do not know for sure.

Q26.9 What happen to
convince Mary it was
Jesus?

When Jesus spoke and called
her by name, she knew it was
Jesus.

Q26.10 Did the Apostles receive that Baptism of the Holy Spirit according to vs. 22?

No. They would receive the Baptism of Holy Spirit later.

Q26.11 So what did they receive when Jesus breathed upon them?

It is likely a statement of a future event.

Q26.12 How can the Apostles forgive sins as recorded in vs. 23?

They can't directly. Only God can forgive sins. By their preaching and people responding to the gospel message, God can forgive sins.

Q26.13 Does Jesus expect people to believe in Him because others says so?

No.

Q26.14 Why did John write this gospel?

Believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, that believing you may have life.
