

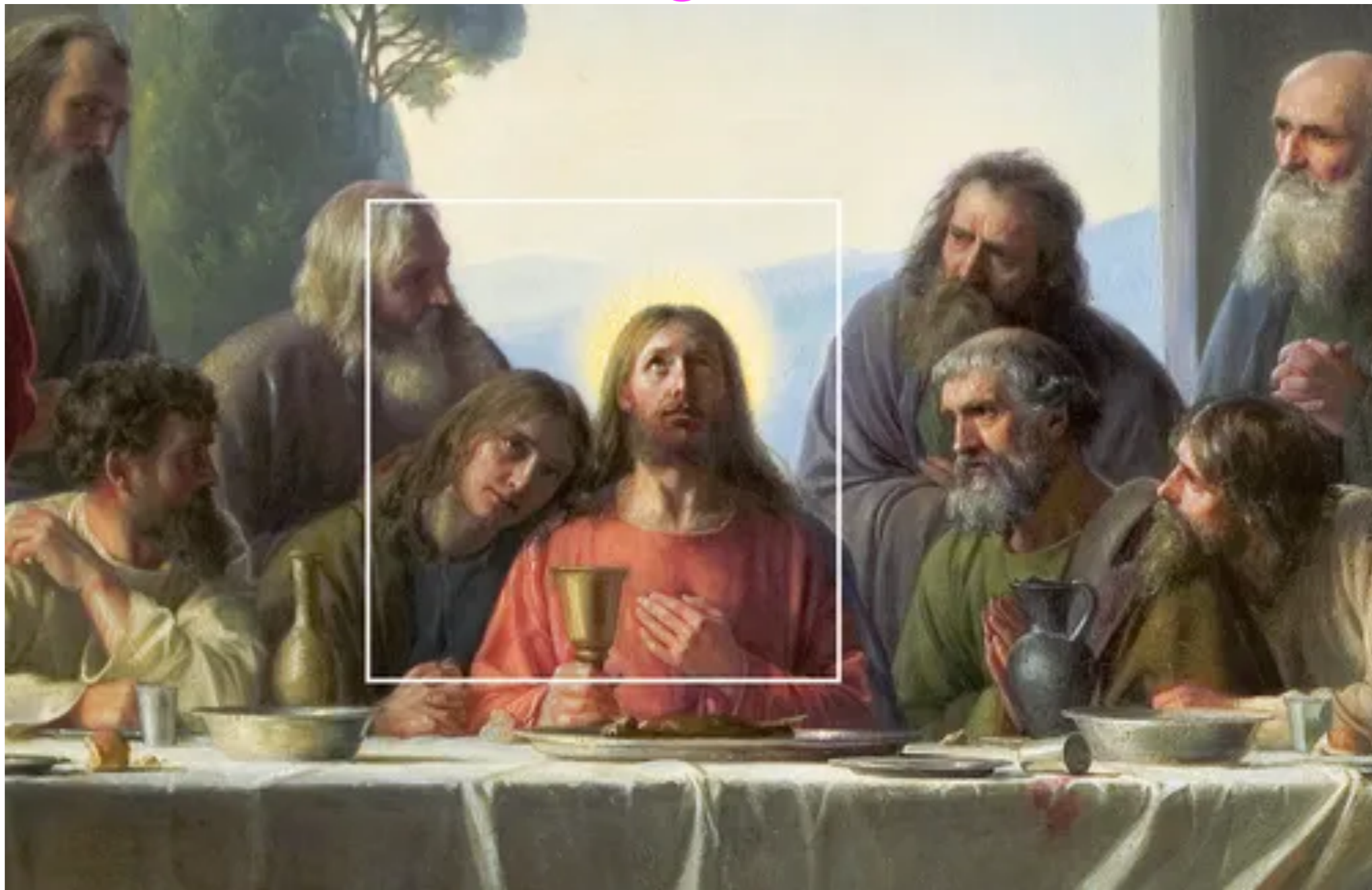

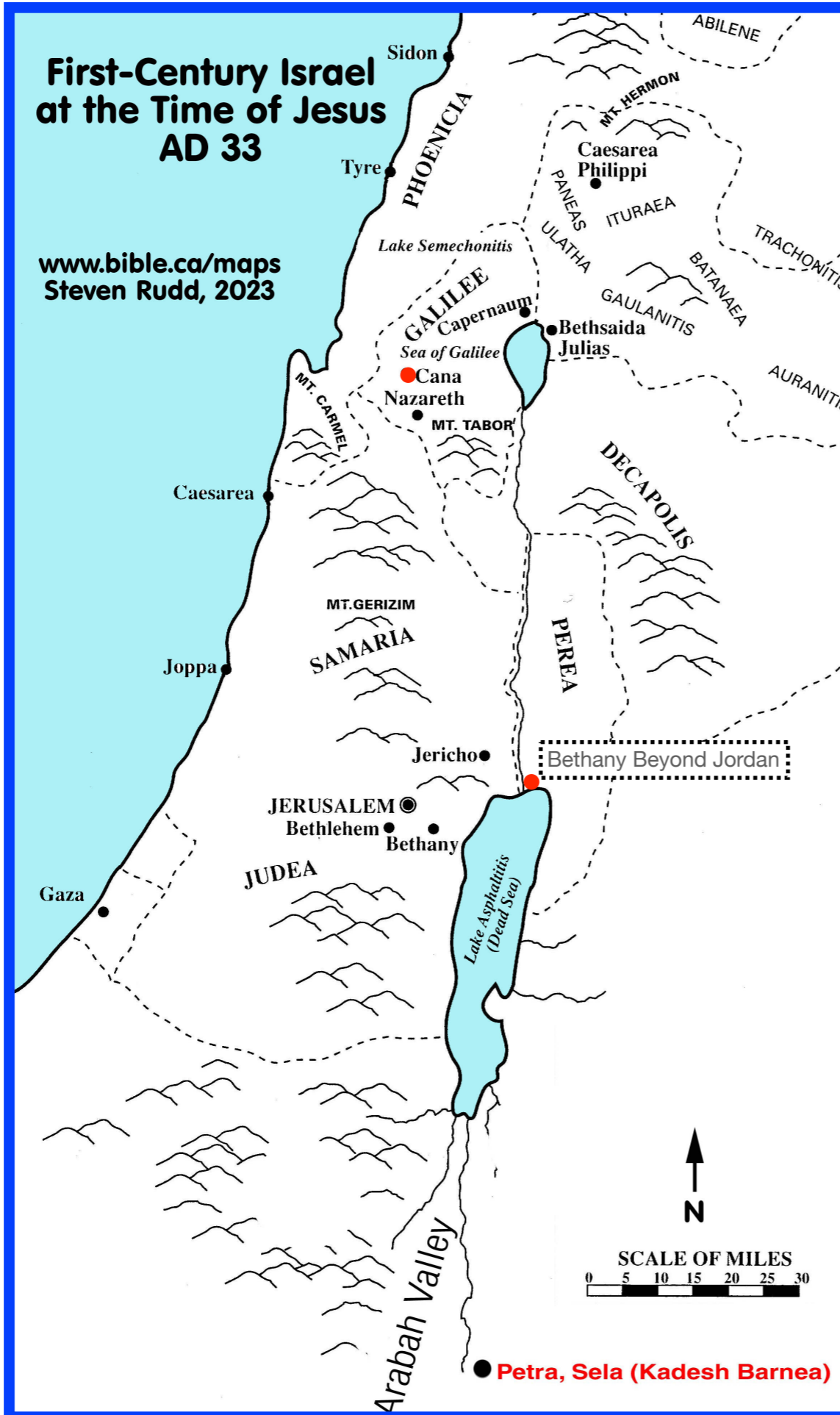

**Q4.1.** Where is "Cana of Galilee" and "Bethany Beyond the Jordan" located at? What is the distance between these two locations? How long would it take to walk.

- 70 miles. 2-3 days to walk.

**Q4.2.** Construct a possible time line of events that have happened with the time indicators provided in the text.

- Day 1 (1:19-28): Testimony of JB.
- Day 2 (1:29): Lamb of God.
- Day 3 (1:35): Call His 1st Three Disciples.
- Day 4 (1:43): Call P. & N.; Purpose-Galilee, travel.
- Day 5: Travel.
- Day 6 (vs. 2:1): Travel, Wedding (3rd day started).

**Q4.3** What is significance of John detailing the days when these events occurred?

Provides us veracity of written testimony.

**Q4.4** Who was invited to the wedding feast?

Jesus, his mother, his disciples and his brothers (vs. 12).

**Q4.5** In vs. 11, it states that this miracle manifested His glory and His disciples believed in Him. Is this the first occasion of their belief?

No.

**Q4.6** In vs. 4, is Jesus responding to his mother in a non-respectful way by calling her “woman” (19:26)?

No.

**Q4.7** In vs. 4, is Jesus saying His time is not ready to perform miracles by stating “My hour has not yet come” (7:30, 12:23, 17:1)? If so why did He perform a miracle?

My hour is used in this gospel to refer to his death, burial and resurrection, 7:30, 12:23, 17:1.

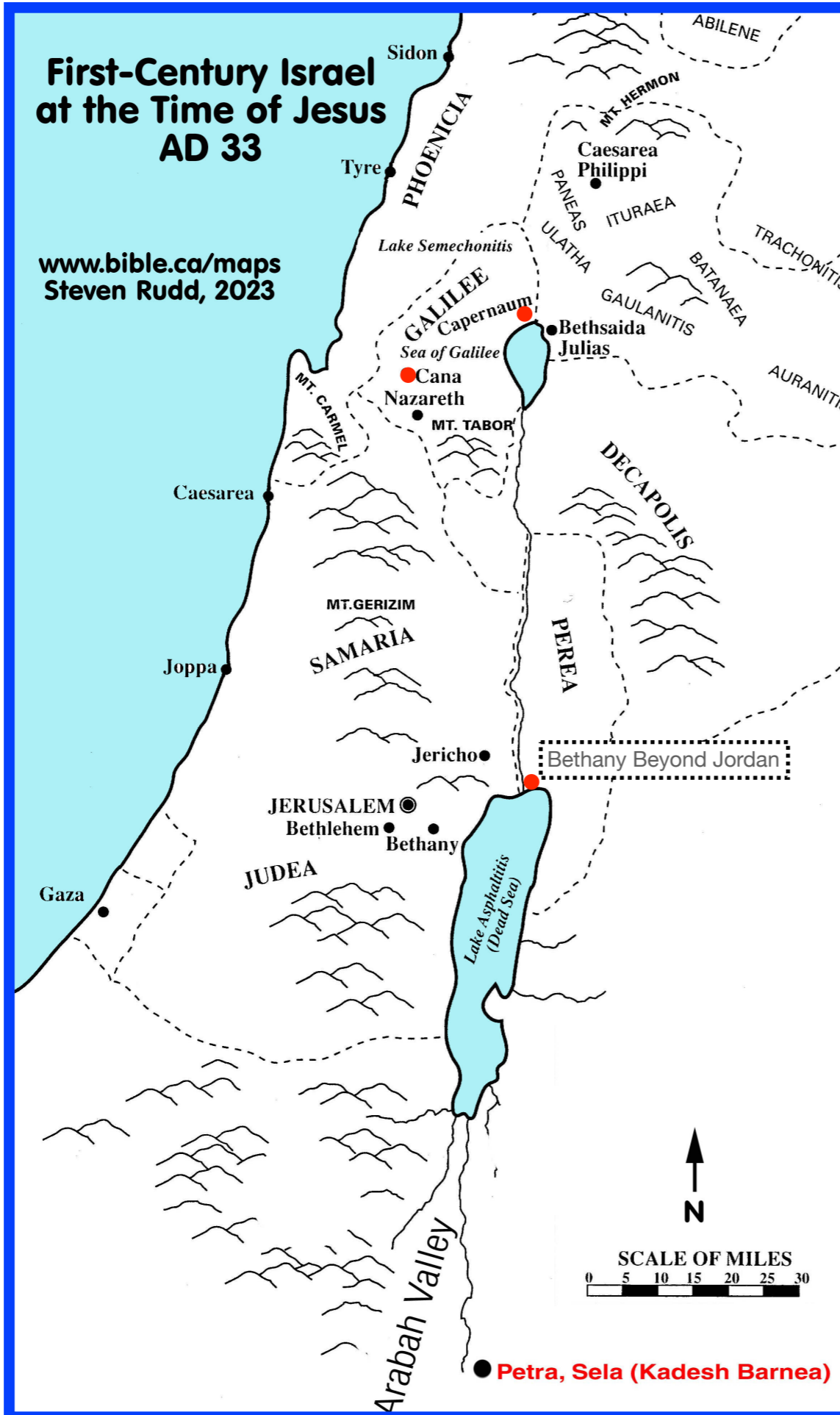


**Q4.8** Is this wine, alcoholic?

Using the 4 Passovers  
mentioned in this Gospel.

**Q4.11** In vs. 14, selling oxen, lambs and doves was occurring. What this wrong (Deut. 14:23-26)?

No.

**Q4.12** So why did Jesus indict these sellers and money changers?

Evidently, these people were making a profit and detracting from worshiping God properly.

**Q4.13** Did the disciples on their own make the connection from this [redacted] prophecy and apply it to the Messiah?

Likely not.

**Q4.14** In vs. 19, who did Jesus say would destroy this temple?

- Doesn't say.



**Q4.15** What does it mean in vs. 23 when it says “many believed in His **name**”?

- Name is put for the person and believe in what is connected to the person in the context.

**Q4.16** On what basis did the people believe?

The signs He performed.
