

Yes. Vs. 29, 39. Jesus knew her marital history.

48. What caused the Samaritans to believe in Jesus?

Testimony of the woman, vs. 39.
Heard Jesus speak, vs. 42.

49. What did the Samaritans believe about Jesus?

- He was the Messiah.
- Salvation was for all mankind.
- Savior.
- Possibly recognized His mission was spiritual and not physical.

General/Universal.

3. When was the Book written?

Uncertain: 60-100 AD.

4. Where was the Book written?

Ephesus (secular sources).

5. Why was the Book written?

20:30-31. Believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; believing you have life.

6. What was written? Provide a simple 3 point outline.

Prologue, 1:1-18.
Discourses & Miracles, 1:19-11:56.
Passion Week, 12:1-21:25.

Q7.1 Is the "Feast of Jews" in 5:1 the Passover (2:23, 6:4, 7:2, 10:22, 12:12, 13:1)?

• Very likely. Most prominent feast.

Q7.2 What events have transpired between 2:23 and 5:1 according to this Gospel?

Wedding at Cana, Jesus cleanses the Temple, Nicodemus, John the Baptist exalted, Samaritan Woman, Healing Royal Official's Son, Healing at the Pool.

Q7.4 Who takes offense to Him working this miracle?

Jewish Leaders.

Q7.5 What did the Law say about working on the Sabbath (Lev. 23:3, Deut. 5:13-14)? Did Jesus violate the Sabbath?

The Law stated that no working i.e. earning a living should be performed on the Sabbath. No.

Q7.6 Which of the 3 attributes in 1:1 does this statement in vs. 17 appeal to?

Word was with God.

Q7.7 In vs. 19, does that statement "the Son can do nothing" mean God the Father gives power to the Son to act?

No. Contrary to all evidence/ testimony already presented.

Messiah sitting on His Throne [Dan. 7:13-14].

Q7.11 What are the 5 witnesses and what verses do they occur?

31 "If alone bear witness of Myself. My testimony is not true.

32 "There is another who bears witness of Me, and I know that the testimony which He bears of Me is true.

33 "You have sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth.

34 "But the witness which I receive is not from map, Bt say these things that you may be saved.

35 "He was the lamp that was burning and was shining and you were willing to rejoice for a while in his light.

<u>36</u> "But the **wtness of AC IES** is greater than *that of* John; for the **works** which the Father has given Me to accomplish, the very works that I do, **bear witness** of Me, that the Father has sent Me.

37 "And the **Father** who sent Me, He has **borne witness** of Me. You have neither heard His voice at any time, nor seen His form.

<u>38</u> "And you do not have His word abiding in you, for you do not believe Him whom He sent. **5.** Scripture

39 You search the **Scriptures**, because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is these that **bear witness** of Me;
