

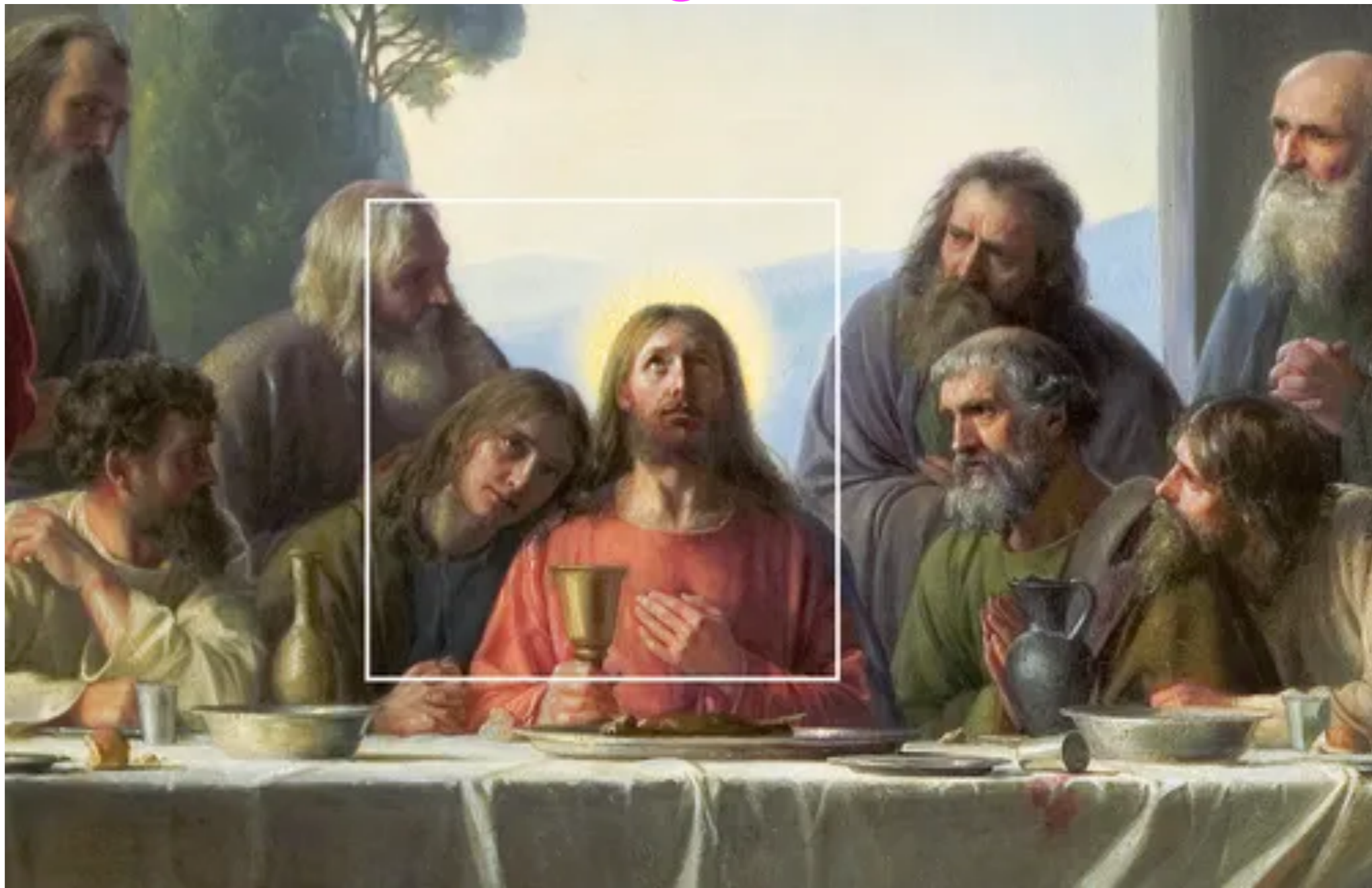

Not meant to record a significant portions of Jesus Ministry.

Q8.3 Why was the
Gospel of John written?

Proof treatise to show Jesus is Deity..

Q8.4 Jesus went “up on the mountain” in vs. 3. What event happened here which is not recorded in John but is in the other Gospels (Matt. 5:1, Luke 6:12,20)?

Sermon on the Mount.

Q8.5 Where is Jesus precisely during the feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10)?

Bethsaida.

Q8.6 Why did Jesus ask Phillip “where are we to buy bread” and not the other disciples (2:43-45, 12:20-21)?

Possibly Philip was from Bethsaida and his outgoing nature.

ask this question?

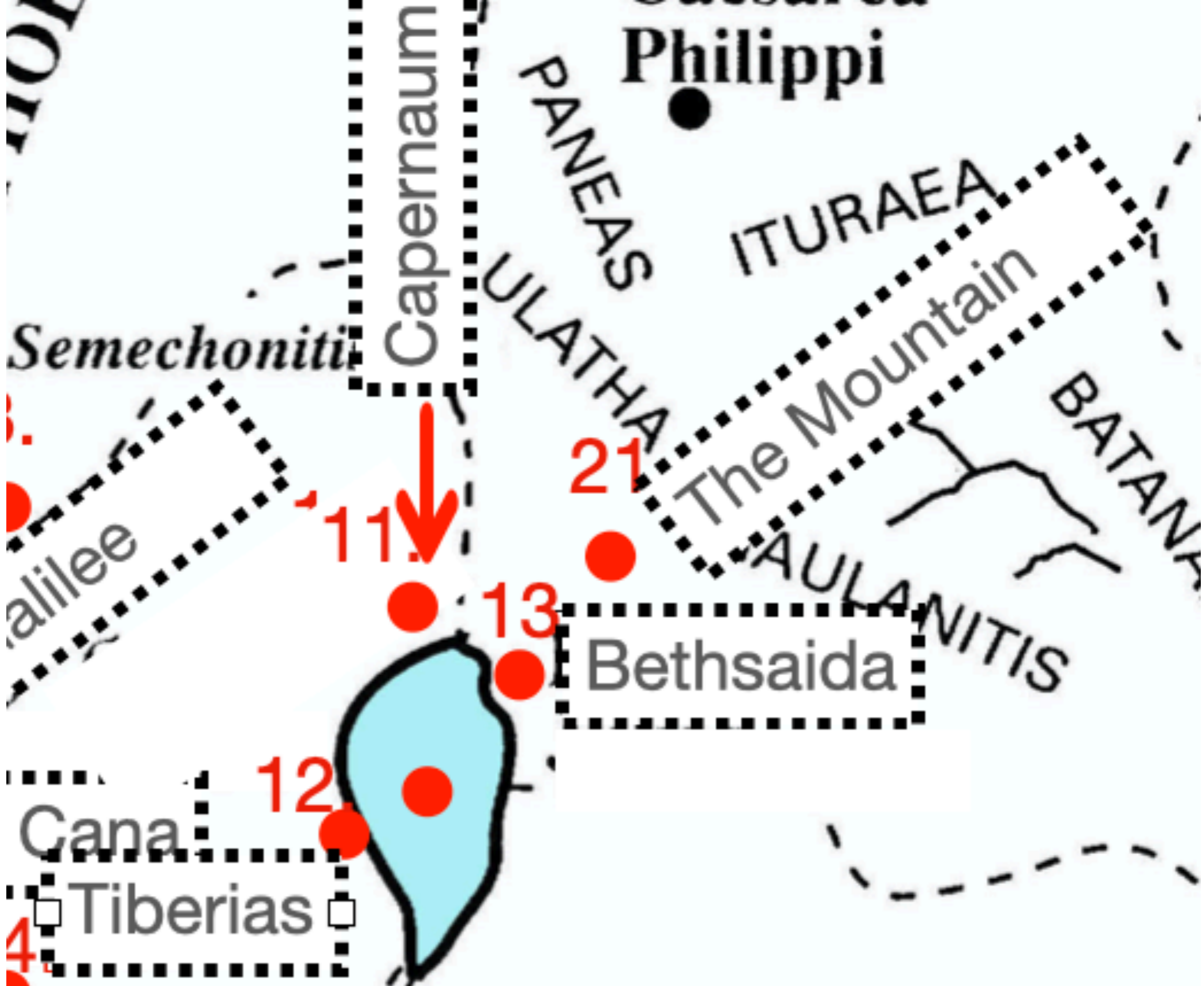
To test him.

disciples going?

Capernaum.



Q8.10 Why did Jesus not go with them at the beginning?

Not sure.

Q8.11 Why wait for so long before come to them by walking on the water?

Don't know for sure.

Q8.12 In vs. 27, is Jesus advocating not working for a living? Explain the meaning of this verse.

Classic “not-but” Hebrew idiom is presented. Work for the food that endures to eternal life.

Q8.13 What is the Work of God?

Believe in Him.

Q8.14 What are the people to believe in about Jesus?

Jesus is the Son of God, provides eternal life and believe in Him to access life.
