

AI – Useful But Dangerous

- The Internet: great for learning, shopping... but also used for pornography, slander, lies.
- "Artificial" Intelligence: created by fallible humans.
- Be aware: Like all tools, AI reflects the values and flaws of its creators.

“Artificial” Knowledge

Can only answer what humans program into it.

- Humans can be ignorant (**Luke 24:25-27**)
- Humans can be prejudiced (**Matthew 27:13-18**)
- Humans may have corrupt aims (**Acts 16:19-21**)

Manipulated Answers

Answers change based on input.

- Biased questions → biased answers.
- Example: "Saved by faith only?" → **John 3:16;**
Ephesians 2:8
- Real study: Consider ALL scripture!

Incomplete Data

- Data can be *omitted* or *added*.
- Experiments: relevant verses left out (**Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21**).
- Garbage in, garbage out!

Created by Fallible Men

- Subject to error.
- AI is only as good as its programming.
- Even experts warn: “Your favorite AI chatbot is full of lies.”
- Always fact-check (See footnote article).

Careless Study & Plagiarism

- Tempting to copy answers.
- True understanding takes time: reading, context, grammar, harmony.
- Bible study demands diligence (**1 Tim 4:11-16**)

Spiritual Consequences

- Quick answers can mislead.
- Mistakes affect your relationship with God (**Matthew 12:2-3,5,7; 15:14**).
- Preachers and teachers: Do your homework!

Parents – Be Alert!

AI has no morals.

- Can produce nudity, profanity, lies.
- Parents: Know what your children use AI for (**Ephesians 6:4**).
- Mothers: Be aware in your household (**1 Tim 5:14**).

Who Is Teaching Your Kids?

- Should AI give counsel, moral instruction?
- Children can't let AI be a surrogate parent.
- Be cautious: AI prayers, AI counseling, AI sermons... even AI spouses!

Final Warning

- AI is a tool: Use wisely.
- Always verify with scripture.
- Trust God's word over any machine.
- "Beware!" – Use for good, avoid evil!
