FAITH & HOPE Hebrews 11:1; Romans 8:18-25

Do you believe in Heaven... i.e., have faith in it's existence...what about hope of heaven?

Do you have hope of heaven? How confident are you of THAT?

Hope = desire and confident expectation of receiving that desire in regard to God's word re. HOW to get there.

FAITH & HOPE Hebrews 11:1; Romans 8:18-25

- How are FAITH & HOPE related?
- Which is dependent upon the other?
- We read of faith:
- "Now faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God."
 - Romans 10:17

Consider this concept as it relates to HOPE

Is your FAITH based upon HOPE? 'I hope I get to heaven...' or, Is your HOPE based upon FAITH? 'I expect to be there...'

You may <u>believe</u> in heaven; do you <u>hope</u> in heaven? Your hope is as strong as your faith.

In order to benefit from HOPE, God has put it in a format that will be understood by those who seek to understand His will.

- To understand HOPE, we find in the bible that the things which we hope for are used in place of the word HOPE.
- This is a concept known as metonymy [figurative language]; that consists of the substitution of a word referring to an attribute for the thing that is meant...
- Examples: "the bottle" for "strong drink", or "count heads/ n o s e s " for "count people"; the use of the <u>throne</u> to refer to a monarch's <u>rule</u>.

So also with attributes of 'HOPE'

Hope is not visible with the naked eye; it is dependent upon faith (Romans 10:17). We can't see the things we hope for; we accept them by faith.

This can be seen from the things we hope for:

- Titus 1:1-2 "...in hope of <u>eternal life...</u>"
- ETERNAL LIFE isn't visible, but based upon FAITH in what God's word has said about it -(Romans 10:17)

Eternal life is based upon faith; as is hope of it.

- 1 Peter 1:17-21 our faith and hope are said to be <u>in God</u>.
- We hope in GOD, yet He is not visible with the naked eye. However, the Creation gives His evidence (Romans 1:20)
- God is not physically visible (no idol); neither is our hope in Him. It is based/dependent on faith.

- Col. 1:27 Christ is the basis of hope.
- Christ "in you" as our hope of glory. Is Christ physically visible? Is glory physically visible?
- How does Christ 'dwell' in us? (Eph. 3:17 through faith) (Col. 3:16 - Let the word of Christ dwell...).
- The 'dwelling' is not visible, but the results of this dwelling are visible from the life we live.
- The 'visible-ness' is in seen from the obedience of our faith.

- 1 Tim. 1:1 Christ is the basis of hope...HOW SO?
- "Christ Jesus our hope" is based upon His being resurrected (yet this is based on per testimony of God's word - Romans 10:17)
- Christ is "our hope" based upon our faith in God's statement of fact about eternal life is possible thru Him.
- Any "visible" proof of the resurrection, or is there testimony that requires faith?

Descriptions of HOPE

- 2 Thess. 2:16 This hope is called 'good', and exists because of God's grace;
- God has given us...eternal comfort and good hope by grace
- grace is not visible with the naked eye; only the results (as is true of the wind).

- Titus 2:13 as a 'blessed' hope, it is a hope wherein we wait for "...the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ..."
- His return is based upon faith in what God has said about a return - John 14:3 - "…if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again…"

Remember:

 Romans 8:25 - <u>if we hope for what we do not</u> see, with perseverance we wait eagerly for it.

 1 Peter 1:3 - he has caused us to be born again to a <u>living</u> hope - - - > HOW?

This birth was made possible by the word:

 1 Peter 1:23 - you have been born...by the...word of God...

 Heb. 7:19 - while "...the Law made nothing perfect...on the other hand there is a bringing in of a better hope, <u>through which</u> <u>we draw near to God</u>.

DRAWN to God by HOPE?



John 6:44-45 - No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day. It is written in the prophets, '<u>AND THEY SHALL ALL</u> <u>BE TAUGHT OF GOD</u>.' Everyone who has heard and learned from the Father, comes to Me.

Romans 10:17 - "Now faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God."
