- Gen 3:20, "the man [Adam, KJV, NKJV] called his wife's name Eve"...?

Arbitrary

Descriptive

"Adam"

- First man
- Wife" Eve
- Address: Eden
- Age: 930 yrs.

Could call him "Bull" and these things be true of him just as well.

"Adam" - i.e. man

Why not "Bull"?

"Bull" describes an adult male animal ...

- animal
- adult
- male

Note: could *arbitrarily* name a bull, "Adam"

"church of Christ" describes

body of believers redeemed in Christ

Mt 16:18; Ac 2:41,47; Heb 12:23;

1Co 12:13...27; Heb 1:3...22-23

"church of Christ" describes

body of believers working and worshipping together as a team in a community in those duties peculiar to their being in Christ

"Baptist Church"? "Lutheran Church"? - arbitrary
"Church of Christ" church just as arbitrary!
