“Will be saved” from ... ?

- **wrath 1:18**
- **judgment 1:32, 2:2**
- **death 6:23**
- **ungodliness, sin 11:26,27**

“Whoever will call on the name of the Lord” Rom 10:13

“Will call on the name of the Lord” ?

“Call on NAME” (v13) =

“Call on HIM” (v14)

Fig. of speech, e.g., Ps 20:1; Mt 6:9

Phrase Itself (*OT background* **Joel 2:32**)

PRAYER of faith **2Sam 22:4..7**

WORSHIP of faith **Psa 20:1-3**

PEOPLE who trust, rely in God

Zec 13:9; 2Tim 2:22

Negatively **Psa 79:6**

APPEAL OF FAITH, RELIANCE, TRUST

What it does NOT mean in **Rom 10**

- **FAITH ALONE?**
 - “if you confess” **v9-10; Jn 12:42**
 - **Rom 10:14,15** - FIVE things
 - **Rom 10:21** - requires obedience
- **PRAYER?**
context?

What it DOES mean in Rom 10

- **Jesus' testimony** Mk 16:15,16
- **Divine application** Ac 2:21f (Joel 2:32)
 - v21** *“calls on the n. of the Lord...saved”*
 - v22-36** - identifies the “Lord”
 - v37** *“what shall we do?”*
 - v38** *“r. & b. in the name of JC ... f. of sins”*
 - v41** *“baptized ... added”*
 - v47** added ... *“being saved”*

Prayer? **AFTER** saved! **v42**

What it DOES mean in **Rom 10**

- **Divine parallel Ac 22:16**
- **Roman readers Rom 6:3-4,17**
- **Appeal to Him for salv. in OBED. faith!
v21; 1:5...16:26 (10:15)**

“Gospel”! 10:15; 1:16,17

1 Pt 3:21 - appeal of FAITH

“Christians” = people who “*call on the name of the Lord*” for guidance, sustenance, protection, and deliverance! **Ac 9:14,21, 1Co 1:2, 2Tim 2:22**
