## Why did Jesus tell the apostles not to go to the Gentiles? Matthew 10:5-6

#### Who Cares?

- Criticism others can make
  - "Jesus didn't care about the Gentiles if he told the apostles not to preach to them. That's not fair."
- What will your answer be when it happens? (1 Peter 3:15)
- God desires all to be saved (1 Timothy 2:3-6)
- Past attempts to bring Gentiles to repentance:
  - Nineveh (Jonah 1:2)

#### Reason #1: Jesus sent to Israel

- Matthew 15:24- I was sent to Israel
- Amos 9:11-12- Raise up the booth of David that is fallen
- Romans 15:8- Christ became a servant of the Jews to show God's faithfulness
- Matthew 10:6-7- Go to the lost sheep of Israel
- Jesus wanted to bring the Jews to him- Matthew 23:37
  - But they rejected him

#### Reason #2: Gentiles were not prepared

#### How were the Jews prepared for Jesus?

- God made Abraham three promises, and fulfilled them (Gal 3:7-9; Acts 13:26-33)
- God gave Moses the law that was a shadow of redemption in Christ (Gal 3:24-15; Heb 8:1-7; 10:1-4)
- David made prophecies about Jesus (Psalm 132:11-12; Acts 2:29-30; Acts 2:32-35)
- Jews were supposed to understand what was going on by studying the prophecies.
- Jews still didn't recognize Jesus as the Christ when he came (Acts 13:27)
- If the Jews didn't figure it out, how were the Gentiles going to?

# Reason #3: It wasn't the right time, but their time came soon after

- Prophecies said gentiles would be saved too
- Simeon declared Jesus a light to the Gentiles- Luke 2:29-32
- Paul was chosen to proclaim God's name to the Gentiles Acts 9:15
  - Peter was sent to visit the Gentiles- Acts 15:14-18

### God wants you to be saved

- Hear (Romans 10:17)
- Believe (John 3:16)
- Confess (Romans 10:9)
- Repent (Acts 2:38)
- Be baptized (Mark 16:16)
- Remain faithful (Revelation 2:10)
- Ask God for forgiveness (1 John 1:9)
