

Teach ...

- **Mk 16:15** “all the world”
- **Rom 1:7** “all...called saints” (23 letters)
- **2Th 3:6...15** “brother ... unruly ... admonish”

Teaching to influence people for Christ

(this lesson - not doctrine, but manner)

Views ...

- Not offend ... hurt feelings ... tell wrong?
- ~~Confrontation~~ ... might turn away
- “with grace”? Col 4:6 (discuss later)

Teaching to influence people (*manner*)

How decide...?

- **Business seminars, classes?**
- **Books by prominent influencers?**
- **Results - big numbers?**
- **Preacher? Elder? Friend? “Dad”?**

Col 4:5-6 ...?


“with grace”?
