2Th 3:6...15 "brother ... unruly ... admonish"

- Views ...

 - Confrontation ... might turn away
 - "with grace"? Col 4:6 (discuss later)

Not offend ... hurt feelings ... tell wrong?

- Preacher? Elder? Friend? "Dad"?



Teaching ... How decide "how"...? Ps 119:9 ... 24 ... 99-100 ... 105 **Stephen Ac 6:8** Ac 7:51-59 (love - spirit of forgiveness v60) Paul Gal 1:15-16 1Co 3:1-3; Gal 2:11-4; 3:1 (enemy? 4:16) Timothy 2Tim 1:5 2Tim 4:1-5 ("work of an evangelist")

Col 4:5-6 ...? "with grace"? Stephen, Paul, Timothy...etc. "grace" = attitude of the <u>speaker</u> "seasoned with salt"?
