

12 times in gospels...at Jesus feet...

WHY were they at Jesus feet?

Lk 7:36-50 “at his feet, weeping” (v38)

Because “she loved much” for “her sins, which are many have been forgiven” (v47)

Contrast Simon — Jesus did! (v44-46)

WHY did he invite Jesus ... ? (v36)

Pride? (Jn 5:44)

Test Him? (v39)

WHY do we attend... “worship” ... ?

Pride? ... Tradition? ... Duty?

LOVE?!

Mk 7:24-30 “*fell at his feet*” (v25)

In order to “*keep asking*” v26

Mt 15:23 “*she keeps shouting at us*” NAS95

Heb 4:14-16 “*let us draw near with confidence*”

Eph 6:18; Col 4:2; 1Th 5:17

Mk 14:3-9

“she has done what she could” v8

Some things she could NOT do...

- ***Stop the Jews from giving Him an unfair trial***
- ***Could not stop Pilate from sentencing Him***
- ***Could not stop those who spit on & slapped Him***
- ***Could not stop the soldiers from scourging Him***
- ***Could not stop them from nailing Him to the cross***
- ***Could not stop the people from mocking Him***
- ***Could not stop Him from dying.***

BUT ...*she did “what she could”*

Many things we can't do...

BUT do we do “what we can” ??

- *Assembling (compare work...??)*
- *Singing (do we...? Or... “I can't” sing well)*
- *Giving. See **Lk 21:1-4***
- *Teaching (“can't teach” anybody ... anything...?)*
- *Life godly life*
- *Active love for Christ’ “brothers” — call, visit, hospitality, service (food, rides, etc.), teach, encourage ...etc. **Mt 25:40***

Mt 25:15...26!

Rev 3:20-22

If “at the feet” of Jesus NOW ...
“sit down with” Him on His throne
